# U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

### (For the month of August2015)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of August, 2015 is highlighted below.

# A. <u>Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works</u>:

- (i) New Major Works started during the month of August, 2015:
  - Foundation Stone for Construction of New Pedestrian Bridge at Damanganga River, Daman at a cost of Rs. 19.45 Crore was laid by Hon'ble Administrator, on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.
  - Foundation Stone for Construction of New KachigamMagarwada
     Bridge at Damanganga River, Daman at a cost of Rs. 47 Crore was laid by Hon'ble Administrator, on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.
  - Foundation stone for construction of Multi Office Complex for P.W.D. opposite Police Out Post, Moti Daman has been laid down by the Chief Engineer on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2015 and the work will be completed at the cost of Rs. 7 crore.
