## U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR

#### **DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

#### (For the month of April, 2016)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of April, 2016 is highlighted below.

#### A. <u>Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works</u>:

#### (i) Major Works completed during the month of April, 2016:
