U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of March 2016)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of March, 2016 is highlighted below.

A. <u>Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works</u>:

- (i) New Major Works started during the month of March, 2016:
- Foundation stone for construction of 12 MLD water supply scheme at Magarwadand of 20.5 MLD at Dabhel, Nani Daman were laid by Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu on 26th March, 2016. These projects will be completed at a cost of Rs. 56.10 Crore.
- The foundation stone was laid by Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu for construction of Adivasi Cultural Centre at Moti Daman. The project will be completed at a cost of Rs. 4.68 Lakh. The work will be completed in next 9 months.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of March, 2016:

- The Administrator, U.T. of Daman and Diu has inaugurated the Community Hall near Bus Stand, Ghoghla, Diu on 21st March, 2016.
- Construction of Fiber Shed for the open passage at Collectorate– Diu was completed at a cost of Rs 0.44 Crore on 15th March, 2016.
- Construction of Fiber Roof shed at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs. 0.12 Crore on 30th March, 2016.

- Renovation, Repairing and Replacement of old slab of 8 'A' type quarters for Police Department, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs.
 0.40 Crore on 25th March, 2016.
- Construction of Civil Engineering & Chemical Engineering building at Government Polytechnic, Daman was completed at a cost of Rs. 5.11 crore.
- Development of Cricket Ground at Government College, Nani Daman was completed at a cost of Rs. 5.11 Crore.

B. <u>Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes</u> during the month of March, 2016:
