U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR

DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of May, 2016)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of May, 2016 is highlighted below.

A. <u>Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works</u>:

(i) Major works started during the month of May, 2016:

- The work for establishment of 220/66Kv Sub-station at Ringanwada in the UT of Daman & Diu has been initiated. The work should be completed by the end of December at a cost if Rs. 38 Crore.
- The District Panchayat, Diu has initiated **22 Developmental Projects** at a cost of **Rs. 4.60 Crore**.
- Daman Municipal Council has issued work order for 3 Developmental works with a total cost of Rs. 0.55 Crore.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of May, 2016:

- The District Panchayat, Diu has completed 8 Developmental projects at a cost of Rs. 1.17 Crore.
- The works of strengthening of Flood Protection Wall, reconstruction of Jetty Platform and construction of Fishing Jetty at Diu have been completed at Diu at a cost of Rs. 1 Crore.
- Laying of G.I. water supply pipeline and replacement of old water supply pipeline at daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 0.62 Crore.

 Replacement of old existing water supply pipeline at different place in varkund village, Nani Daman was completed at a cost Rs.
 0.39Crore

B. <u>Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes</u> <u>during the month of May, 2016:</u>

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of May, 2016 is as follows:

> ICDS

- Provided nutritious food to 5885 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided Food grain to1537 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided nutritious food to 703 Adolescent Girls School Going.
- Provided nutritious food to 755 Adolescent Girls Out of School.

Pension released to11246Old Age pensioners, WidowPensioners and
 Disabled pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

Animal Husbandry

 Provided 195 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg base to 18 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

Crop Husbandry

 Tractors facility has been provided to 20 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations. One day training programme was organized by the Agriculture Department on "Paddy Cultivation" in SansadAadarsh Gram, Pariyari, Moti Daman.

> Agriculture

 Agriculture Department, District Panchayat, Daman supplied 8916 Kgs of paddy seeds to 333 farmers during the month of May, 2016. 07 farmers were provided storage bins sets and 4 farmers were provided tool implement sets. Further, 3 farmers were also provided Sprayer Pump sets during the month of May, 2016.

C. Economic Development & Industries for the Month of May 2016:

- The Report on "Gross State Domestic product (GSDP)" was computed by the National Council of Applied Economic Research, New Delhi in respect of both the UTs for the year 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13. As per the report the Per Capita GSDP (Rs. per capita) was Rs. 2,07,609/-, Rs. 2,53,542/-, Rs. 2,55,818/-, Rs. 2,30,168/- and Rs.2,12,087/- respectively in the UT of Daman & Diu.
- New Investment of Rs.2.81 Crore with employability of 80 Persons has been generated in the UT of Daman & Diu.

D. <u>Organization of important Events during the month of May,</u> 2016:

 A review meeting for "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" was held on 30th May, 2016 under the chairmanship of the Chief Executive Officer, District Panchayat, Daman. Concerned agency was directed to place sufficient numbers of Dustbins in rural areas of Daman district.

- "National Level Bal Shree Selection Camp" was organized by the Bal Bhavan Board, Daman in which two students were selected for participation in National Level Bal Shree Competition conducted by the National Bal Bhavan, New Delhi on 3rd and 4th May, 2016.
- "Summer Camp 2016" was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Daman From 2nd May to 8th June, 2016, Various activities like Tie & Die, Terra Cotta, Quilling, Puppet Making, Miniature and Madhubani Painting, Etc. was organized by the department. A total of 236 students participated in this camp.

 Basic Fire Safety Training to the General Public was given at Royal Home, TankiFaliya, Dunetha, Nani Daman, on 20th May, 2016 and Zaar Apartment, Full wadi behind Police Station, Moti Daman on 28th May, 2016 by the Fire Department.
