

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of February 2014)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of February, 2014 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) New Major Works started during the month of February, 2014:

- Foundation stone for extension of Padmabhushan Sports Complex, Diu at a cost of Rs.6.63 crore was laid by Hon'ble Administrator U.T. of Daman & Diu on 28th February, 2014. The extension includes construction of an Olympic size swimming pool as well as indoor facilities for squash, gymnasium and dormitory.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of February, 2014:

- Replacement of 600 mm dia existing gravity main water supply pipeline between Somnath junction to Kachigam junction at Nani Daman.
- Conversion of 600 mm dia existing gravity main water supply pipeline between HGLR High base to O IDC road, Dabhel, Nani Daman.
- Beautification of Daman-Devka and other District road by providing paver block flooring with curb stone upto available government land from Tin Batti to Hotel Princess Park and construction of storm water drain from Jupiter Distillery upto Government Hospital, Marwad, Nani Daman.
- The Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu has inaugurated the Transit Hostel building for visiting doctors at Ghoghla, Diu on 28th February, 2014 completed at a cost of Rs.87 lakh.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiary Oriented Schemes during the month of February, 2014 :

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of February, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Free supply of horticulture/fruits plants (100% subsidy) to 223 SC/ST/SM farmers.
- Supply of Paddy, Pulses, tools/Implements, Sprayer Pumps, Storage bin set and Agriculture machinery (50 % Subsidy) to 98 farmers.
- Tractors facility has been provided to 5 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.
- 2804 Nos of Hybrid vegetables seedlings distributed to farmers at nominal cost.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

- Provided 655 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg base to 655 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Fisheries**

- Provided assistance amount of Rs.18.36 lakh to 47 fishermen for purchase of fisheries requisites/equipment etc.

➤ **Education**

- Annual Grant of Rs.50,000/- each released to 12 Government Schools and Minor Repair Grant of Rs.25,000/- each released to 9 Government Schools of Daman.
- Provided nutritious food to about 14708 students (Std.I to VIII) under Mid Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released of Rs.0.65 lakh to 13 Mothers under Matru Suraksha Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided nutritious food to 7733 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided Food grains to 1754 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided nutritious food to 1919 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided nutritious food to 387 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC / ST / OBC**

- Cash incentive of Rs.7.45 Lakh released to 2400 parents of SC/ST boy students and Rs.6.94 Lakh to 2200 parent of SC/ST girl students.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to 9387 Old Age Pensioners, Widows Pensioners and Disabled persons under National Social Assistance Programme.
- Subsidy of Rs.70,000/- per beneficiary released to 4 beneficiaries under Indira Awas Yojana.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of February, 2014:

- Open Chess tournament was organized in Navsari on 2nd February, 2014 where ten children of Bal Bhavan, Daman participated and four of them won the medals.
- 19th International Karate Championship was organized at Priyadarshni Sports Complex of Mumbai on 15th and 16th February, 2014, in which 21 states and 10 countries had taken part in which 10 students from Bal Bhavan Daman had participated, out of which 7 of them won.
- World Book Fair was organized at Pragati Maidan, Delhi on 23rd February, 2014 where cultural programmes were performed by Bal Bhavan, Daman
- Two days "Creative Story Composition Meet" on 26th and 27th February, 2014 was conducted by Secretary (Art and Culture) in which the best performer and all the other participants were awarded certificates.
- Study Tour Programme "Krishi Vasant-2014" was organized at Nagpur and 19 farmers have been benefited.
- In-Service Teacher Training was provided to 120 teachers of Government and Aided Secondary Schools of Daman on IEDSS (Inclusive Education for Disable at Secondary Stage) for 5 days from 11th to 15th February, 2014 under RMSA scheme.
- Remedial Teaching was provided to weaker students of Standard Xth of Government Schools, Daman district under RMSA scheme.
- Self Defense training was provided to girls of Government Secondary Schools of Daman district under RMSA scheme.
- National Productivity week was celebrated from 12th to 18th February, 2014. Essay, Painting, Slogan competition relating to the theme was organized.

- Meeting with fishermen association conducted by the Fisheries Survey of India, Mumbai was organized on 5th February, 2014 at Fisheries Office, Daman.
- Fishermen Community Interactive program was organized with Coast Guard Daman at Kadaiya, Machhiwad on 25th February, 2014.
- “Krishi Mela” was organized on 25th February, 2014, in which 2280 farmers have visited the various stalls and upgraded their knowledge on modern Agricultural Techniques.
- State level National award of Rs.25,000/- has been given to three Anganwadi Workers of Daman & Diu district by Hon’ble Union Minister for Women and Child Development, Government of India, New Delhi at “One Day Award Function for conferment of National Awards to Anganwadi Workers” which was held on 27th February, 2014 at 11.30 am in Rajiv Gandhi Sports Stadium, New Delhi.
- Sports Meet at Kachigam Gram Panchayat was organized under the scheme of Panchayat Yuva Krida Khel Abhiyan (PYKKA) in which about 150 participants (Men & Women) of Pariyari Panchayat participated in the event like Tug of War, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Musical Chair and several other games.
- Organization of “Daman District Inter School Girls Cricket Tournament 2013-14” at Football ground, Moti Daman from 13th February, 2014 to 15th February, 2014 in which total 10 teams participated.
- Training of Volleyball U-17 (Boys) team for participating in 59th SGFI Tournament held at Vijaypur.
- IInd Round of Pulse Polio was organized on 23rd February, 2014 in which 27,530 eligible children upto 5 years of age were administered with Polio vaccine in both districts of Daman and Diu.
- Training of Medical Officers and Field Health Functionaries were organized from 14th to 16th February, 2014 under Integrated Disease Surveillance Program.
