# U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

# (For the month of September 2014)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of September, 2014 is highlighted below.

# A. <u>Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works</u>:

### (i) Major Works completed during the month of September, 2014:

- Improvement of infrastructure facilities in Govt. High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools at Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 71.00 lakh.
- Renovation and Repairing of 16 Nos. 'B' type Bachelor quarter at Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 51.00 lakh.
- Construction of additional Class roomsat Govt. Higher Secondary School, Vanakbara, Diuhas been completed at a cost of Rs. 36.00 lakh.
- Construction of Government Godown/Garage, near Pump House at Gandhipara, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 19.00 lakh.
- Repairs & Renovation to Govt. Quarters and Circuit House at Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 10.00 lakh.

# B. <u>Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of September, 2014</u>:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of September, 2014 is as follows:

### > Agriculture

- Sprayer Pumps has been distributed to the 8 Nos. of SC/ST/Small &Marginalized(SM) farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (**02 beneficiaries**) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher (**2 beneficiaries**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

### > Crop Husbandry

Tractors facility has been provided to 2 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

### **Education**

Provided nutritious food to about **9861 students** (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

#### > Technical Education

Stipend of Rs. 1.74 lakh (Rs. 1000/ per month per training) has been paid to 87 numbers of trainees under TSP for 2 months training from 1/07/2014 to 31/08/2014.

### > Development of SC/ST/OBC

- Cash incentive of Rs. 4.90 lakh released to parents of SC/ST boy students.
- Cash incentive of Rs. 4.97 lakh released to parents of SC/ST girl students.

#### > Health

- Financial assistance released for atotal of Rs.2.05 lakhto 41 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs. 41,800/- has been made in the name of 44 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

### > ICDS

- Provided **nutritious food** to 6565 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to 1705 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 732 Adolescent Girls School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 201 Adolescent Girls Out of School.

- The Hon'ble Administrator, UT of Daman & Diu has conducted a meeting of Public Representative and Senior Officers of UTs of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Secretariat, Moti Daman in which it was decided to carry out Special Campaign on "Cleanness drive' from 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 to 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014.

The Cleanness drive was successfully organised in all Panchayats and urban wards of both districts of Daman & Diu.

- A meeting of public representative was held at Collectorate, Daman on 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 to discuss the issue of expansion of new electoral booths in view of increasing population.
