NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (2) of section 6 of Indian Port Act 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908), the Administrator of Daman and Diu and DNH hereby makes the following Rules and further to amend the Goa, Daman and Diu Port Rules, 1983 namely :-

1. (i) These rules may be called Daman and Diu Amendment Port Rules 1999.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Goa, Daman and Diu Port Rules, 1983 (here in after referred to as the Principal Rule).
- (A) In Rule 64 for Schedule 1, 5 & 6 the following Schedule shall be substituted namely :-

1. **Annual License Fees :-**

(a) **Inland Non-Mechanized Craft**

(i)	Upto 2.00 tons per annum	Rs.12/-
(ii)	Above 2.00 tons and upto 5.00 tons per annum	Rs.16/-
(ii)	Above 5.00 tons and upto 10 .00 tons per annum	Rs.20/-
(iii)	Above 10.00 tons and upto 25.00 tons per annum	Rs.30/-
(iv)	Above 25.00 tons First 25 tons per annum	Rs.35/-
	Every addition 20 tons per annum	Rs.05/-

NOTE : The License Fees for the Craft shall be levied 20% less as shown above if the vessel is registered in Daman and Diu Ports.

5. Bonds, Sureties, etc. each Rs. 10/-
6. Change of Tindel of a Craft each Rs. 10/-
- (B) In Rule 64 for Schedule No. 7 to 20 and Schedule No.26 and 54, Port Dues and other fees shall be levied at all the Ports, 30% more as specified in the said schedule.
- (C) In Rule 64 for Schedule No. 22 to 25 as well as 27 to 53 and 55 Port dues and other fees shall be levied at all ports, 50% more as specified in the said schedule.
- (D) In Rule 64 for Schedule No.21, the Port dues and other fees shall be levied at all Ports 30%, as specified in sub-schedule (1) to (4) and the following sub-schedule in the said schedule of 21 shall be added :-

(5) **Land for Commercial purpose in all Ports :-**

(I)	Land for Lorry and Gala	Per 10 sq. Mt. or part thereof per month Rs.150/-
(II)	Land for erection of shop to fish merchant	Per 10 sq.mt. or part thereof per month Rs.20/-
(III)	Land for Industrial and Commercial purpose	Per 10 sq. Mt. or part thereof per month Rs.150/-

- (IV) Any activity of film Shooting or any kind of other shooting/ Photography in Port premises. Per 10 sq.mt. or part thereof per day Rs.50/- Minimum per day Rs.1000/- and visit for sight seeing in Lighthouse Rs.2/- per Adult and Rs.1/- per child above 3 years.
- (V) Any activity of film shooting or any kind of other shooting/ photography within port limit. Rs. 2000/- per a day or part thereof.
- (VI) The rate of fees on sand scoped out of the sea or river and from any where within Port Limit, but not brought from any other Port, landed at any landing place of the Port shall be levied Rs.10/- per tone or part thereof.

(E) In Rule 64, the following schedule shall be added, namely :-

56. The fees for supply of fresh water to vessels shall be charged at the rate specified in the table below :-

Sr. No.	Description	Unit	Coastal	Overseas

(a)	Supplying Water to all vessels	Per 1000 liters or part thereof	Rs.25/-	Rs. 35/-

NOTE :-When water is allowed to be supplied by the vessel's Agent and also supplied on vessels berthed at Jetty/wharf/Pier, the charges of Rs.5/- and Rs.3/- per 1000 litter(ton) or part thereof shall be charged for overseas and coastal vessels respectively.

57. License to vehicles operated within Port Limit

The Fees specified in the table below shall be levied in respect of vehicles operating in all the Ports as per table below :-

NOTE : (I) If any vehicles operating without obtaining a License, Double the fees prescribed above shall be charged.

(II) If any Mechanically propelled vehicle bringing or removing goods to or from or plying for hire within the Port premises enters in the Port without license, temporary permit shall be issued on payment of Rs.10/- per vehicle per day.

(F) In Rule 37, the following shall be substituted namely :-

37. **Appeal against order of the Port Authority** :- An Appeal against an order of the Port Authority under these rules lie to the Secretary Transport to the U.T. Administration of Daman and Diu and DNH, Secretariat, Moti-Daman. Every such appeal shall be preferred in writing fourteen days from the date on which the order of the Port Authority has been communicated in writing to the person concerned. The decision of the Secretary Transport to the U.T. Administration of Daman and Diu and DNH thereon shall be final and binding.

Provided that the Secretary Transport to the U.T. Administration of Daman & Diu and DNH may entertain the appeal after the expiry of the said period of fourteen days if he is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in time.

(G) In Rule 65, the following shall be substituted namely :-

65. **Penalties** :- Any person contravening any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with fine which may extend to two thousand rupees, which may be imposed by the Port Authority, by an order.

(H) After Rule 65, the following rule shall be inserted, namely :-

66. **Improperly discharging Ballast or Rubbish** :- Any person who by himself or another so casts or throws any ballast or rubbish or any such other thing (or so discharged any oil or watermixed with oil) and the master of any vessel from which the same is so cost. (Thrown or discharged) shall be punishable with fine which may extend to (Five Lakh rupees) which may impose by the Port Authority by an order.

1. **Short Title** :- These rules may be called the Administration of Daman & Diu Group 'C' Non-Ministerial post of Craft Instructor (Computer) Recruitment Rules, 1997.
2. **Application** :- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these rules.
