


CONDITIONS FOR THE SUPPLY OF DIETARY ITEMS TO GOVERNMENT
HOSPITAL, DAMAN AND COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER, MOTI DAMAN.

E-Tender (ON LINE)

1. Sealed tenders from the registered supplier having Food Licence issued by Food Department of Daman are invited by the Director of Medical & Health services, Community Health Center, Moti Daman on behalf of the President of India, hereinafter called as the Government for the "Supply of Dietary items" as per Annexure "A" enclosed herewith.
2. The tender inviting authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders to be received without assigning any reasons thereof.
3. (a) The successful tenderer will have to pay within 10 days from the date of demand, an amount equal to 10% of the total value of articles, that may be order, as the amount of security deposit.
(b) Non-receipt of Security Deposit within stipulated time limit will result in automatic cancellation of the order for supply without any intimation.
(c) However in case if any articles are received for which the Security Deposit may not have been deposited, the full Security Deposit as may be due from the supplier will be recovered from the bills for such articles.
4. The Articles of the first quality will be preferred and should correspond with the Government of India grading of any available for the items such as AGMARK, ISI mark etc.
5. The articles will have to be supplied or will be obtained regularly as per daily, weekly, fortnightly or monthly requirement as per the requisite made by the Medical Superintendent, Govt. Hospital, Daman and the Director, Medical & Health Services, Daman.
6. Fruit, vegetable, eggs, meat etc. items of easily consumption are to be supplied daily at a scheduled item as per instruction of the authorised officials, items not according to the specifications and of good quality will not accept.
7. Article not supplied by the tenderers according the requisition will be purchase from the local market and the enter expenditure incurred, if any due to such purchase will be charged to the account of the tenderer and recovered from him.
8. The quality /numbers of the items as specified in the schedule may required more also as per need of the Hospital.
9. Extension of time limit for supplies shall be consider by the tender inviting officer. The extension so granted may be with levy of compensation for delay in execution of supply order upto 5% of cost of supplies ordered for at the discretion of the authority competent to grant extension of time limit provided such request is made well in time, depending upon the circumstances and such decision in the matter will be final.
10. The requisition will be sent in duplicate and two copies should be returned by the contractor endorsing thereon the quantity of each item actually supplied duly signed and dated by him. He should obtain dated acknowledgment from the authorised officials of the unit for the supply made and this should invariable accompany the bills or are liable to rejected.

11. The Director, Medical & Health Services reserves his rights not to purchase or to discontinue purchasing any items covered in the contract or any period during the year and subsequent arrangement is made for their supply by the Government either Departmentally or through the co-operative societies.
12. Tender received after the prescribed time and date or without fulfilling of the prescribed conditions will be summarily rejected.
13. If any dispute arises regarding the operation or interpretation of any of the caused be taken as final, herein mentioned the decision of the Director, Medical & Health Services, Daman.
14. The dealers who have registration with CST/VAT are only required to submit their tenders otherwise summarily rejected.
15. The tenderers are required to produce/attach the following documents with tender in addition to above mentioned documents.
 - i) A copy of Food Licence issued by the Food Department of Daman.
 - ii) A copy of VAT/ST Registration.
 - iii) A copy of PAN/TAN of Income Tax.


