

Specifications of Distress Alert Transmitters (DAT)

Distress Alert Transmitters (DAT) should have the following features.

- (a) Transmission on 402 frequency only.
- (b) Inbuilt GPS to give exact position and time information.
 - (c) It should have provision for transmitting emergencies like fire, Boat sinking, manoverboard, medical help on manual activation. Separate switches for each emergency. The emergencies and its transmitting method to be pictorially explained on instrument itself. Preferably additional switch for indicating strangers. Battery life should be minimum 48 hrs.
- (d) Once activated should continue to transmit for 24 hours for first 5 minutes and thereafter average of every 5-30 min interval for next 24 hrs.
- (e) Should have frequency transmission test facility.
- (f) Should have omni dimensional antenna.
- (g) The equipment should float on water.
- (h) Should have easy fixing and removing provision on board boat with wall mounting accessories included.
- (i) DATs should gives indication on both by light and sound as in case of inadvertent or accidently inadvertent; it can be switched off by the user.
- (j) Further, the technical specifications of DAT are as follows.

- (b) Registration of DATs with MRCC(Chennai) with submission of details of both (in hard and soft copy) as per format promulgated by MRCC(CHN).
- (c) One year warranty for the equipment.
- (d) Testing and proving transmission of all DATs prior handing over to fishermen. MRCC should certify the DATs.
- (e) Service / Spares should be available for a period 5 years from the Date of supply of equipment.
- (f) Companies participating in tender should provide samples and demonstrate.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Tenders are invited by E-Tendering system in Two Bids Tendering System for' Rate Contract Tender for Supply, Installation and Training of "Sea safety equipment Distress Alert Transmitters "at Diu as per the specification given in Annexure II.
- 2. Financial Bid (only price against tender item) is required to prepare separately and submit on-line on website https://daman.nprocure.com. Financial Bid in physical format shall not be accepted in any case.
- 3. Tender Fees of ₹ 1,000/- (Non-Refundable) and E.M.D. of ₹ 50,000/- (Refundable) in form of DD/FDR drawn on any Scheduled/ Nationalized Bank in favour of Superintendent of Fisheries, Daman in original (in physical form) shall be done by R.P.A.D./Speed Post/By Hand Delivery in the office of the Superintendent of Fisheries, Fisheries Department, Daman as per prescribed dated, time & venues as mentioned in the E-Tender Notice. However, Tender Inviting Authority will not be responsible in case of postal delay (refer Terms & Conditions). (You may consult this office for any inquiry].
- 4. Company Profile/Technical Bid containing full information as in Annexure I, along with specification of Distress alert transmitters. Along with catalogues of the product (if available) to be supplied should be done on-line on web site https://daman.nprocure.com.
- 5. In First instance, The Technical Bid will be opened on schedule date and time. Technical Bid of all the bidders will be verified & if found to be satisfactory thereafter the Financial Bids of the eligible Tenderers only will be considered for the said Tender.
- 6. The Tenderer has to submit the sample of DATs to the Supdt. Of Fisheries, Daman within the prescribe time limit. Physical sample of DATs of the Successful bidder will be considered within the supply order.
- 7. Tenders received after due date and time mentioned above will not be accepted.
- 8. The Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman reserves the rights to accept <u>or</u> reject any tender without assigning any reason.
- 9. Tender incomplete in any respect or conditional Tender will not be accepted.
- 10. Tender Fees of Rs.1,000/- (Non-Refundable) and E.M.D. of Rs. 50,000/- (Refundable) in form of DD/FDR drawn on any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank in favour of **Superintendent of Fisheries**, **Daman** in original (in physical form) by R.P.A.D./ Speed Post/By Hand Delivery in the office of the Superintendent of Fisheries, Fisheries Department, Daman shall be uploaded with on-line Technical bid.
- 11. The submission of E.M.D. is compulsory for all the tenderers and scanned copy of the E.M.D. shall be uploaded with On-line Technical bid.
- 12. Bid securities of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after expiry of the final bid validity on or before the 30th days after award of the contract.
- 13. Bid securities of the successful bidder FDR will remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual of the supplier.
- 14. The Head of Office will consider extension of time for remitting the Security Deposit as demanded. However, in case of detail to consider such extension, the supplier is bound to abide by the limit given and liable to make good any loss to the Government on account of his failure to abide by the time limit stipulated.
- 15. The goods shall be nicely packed so that no damage is caused in transportation.
- 16. In case of failure to replace the non-accepted and rejected articles from supplies made as mentioned in the conditions, the loss undergone by the Government will be recovered from the supplier's Security Deposit / Earnest Money or payment due of any bill(s) to the extent required.

- 17. The supplies of equipment etc. of inferior quality / standard or of different specification other than that ordered / specified and/or incomplete or broken articles will not be accepted. The supplier will have to replace the same at his own cost and risk. Intimation of non-acceptance of any stores, machinery and equipment etc. will be sent to the supplier within 15 days from the date of receipt of the stores, machinery
 - and equipment will be returned to the supplier at his own cost and risk, if he so desires and intimates accordingly within 15 days from the date of dispatch of intimated accordingly within 15 days from the date of dispatch of intimation of the non-acceptance. However, if no communication is received within 15 days from the date of communication in the Tender Inviting Officer will not be responsible for any damage, loss, etc. of such rejected articles.
- 18. In case of failure to supply, installed and training of the equipment, etc. ordered for as per the conditions and within the stipulated time, the same articles will be obtained, if required from the tenderer who offered next higher rates or from any other sources, as may be decided by the Tender Inviting Officer and the loss to the Government on account of such purchase (s) shall be recovered from the supplier's Security Deposit / Earnest Money Deposits or bills payable. The suppliers shall have no right to dispute with such procedure.
- 19. If at any time after the order for supply of DATs, the Tender Inviting Officer shall for any reason whatsoever not require the whole or part of the quantity thereof as specified in the order. The Tender Inviting Officer shall give notice in writing of the fact to the supplier (s) who shall have no claim to any payment of compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which the supplier (s) might have derived from the supply of articles in full, but which did not derive in consequence of the full quantity of articles not having been purchased, nor shall have any claim for compensation by reasons of any alterations having been made in the original instructions which shall involve any curtailment of the supplyoriginally contemplated.
- 20. The scope of works covers- The successful bidder shall have to Supply of Distress Alert Transmitters (DATs), Installation of DATs in fishing boats, Training of Fishermen in using DATs at the time of distress, Servicing of malfunctioned DATs as an when required, Make available the spares DATS at least for five years from the date of supply.
- 21. The successful bidder shall have to provide training to the departmental staff and stake holders, general handling / maintenance of DATs.
- 22. The Bidder will provide 1 year warranty/guarantee on all the components and provide free of cost maintenance.
- 23. All bills should be in DUPLICATE, pre-receipted on a Revenue Stamp of proper value, and should invariably mention the number and date of supply order.
- 24. Each bill in which Sales Tax / VAT is charged must contain the following certificate on the body of the bill." Certified that the goods on which Sales Tax / VAT has been charged have not been exempted under the Central Sales Tax & VAT Act or the Rules made there under and the amount charged on account of Sales Tax on these goods is not more than what is payable under the provisions of relevant Act or the Rules made there under".
- 25. The rate should be provided along with the rebate under CSR upto 10 % and F.O.R. concerned Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman & Diu should include excise duty, sales tax, Freight charges, any other taxes rates of imposition whatever liable in respect of the supplies. The Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman shall not be liable to pay any tax, freight etc. which has been expressly stipulated in the tender in the event of acceptance of the tender. Suppliers are bound to pay tax to the Govt. at their own level. No advance payment will be made.
- 26. On acceptance of the tender it will become a contract and shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the tender under the provisions of GFR.
- 27. The Performance Security amount shall stand forfeited in case of breach of any of the conditions mentioned herein and if the services of the contractor are found unsatisfactory.
- 28. The Tendering firms / agencies are required to submit Scan copies of following documents along with Technical Bid which are mandatory, failing to which their bids will be summarily / our-rightly rejected and will not be considered any further:
- (a) Copy of valid License of the UT/State Govt. for the particular supply item for which tender is applied.

- (b) CST/VAT Registration Certificate.
- (c) The current Sales Tax/VAT Clearance Certificate alongwith copy of latest Sales Tax/VAT Deposit Acknowledgement/Challan issued from the Sales Tax/VAT Department must be attached.
- (d) PAN No. and TIN with Income Tax clearance certificate, for last three years.
- (e) Demand Draft in favour of the **Superintendent of Fisheries**, **Daman** amounting to ₹ 1,000/-(Rupees one thousand only) as tender fees in case Tender is downloaded from the Website.
- (f) Demand Draft drawn on Schedule/Nationalized Bank towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of ₹ 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only).
- 29. The Tender should be signed by the authorized person and his/her full name and status should be indicated below his / her signature along-with the official stamping of the firm.
- 30. All entries in the tender form should be legible and filled clearly. If the space for furnishing information is not sufficient, as separate sheet duly signed by the authorized signatory may be attached. No overwriting or cutting is permitted in the financial bid Form. In such cases, the tender shall be summarily rejected.
- 31. The tenderers will have to bid for all the items and not in parts inclusive of all applicable taxes.
- 32. The tenderer will be bound by the details furnished by him /her to this office, while submitting the tender or at subsequent stage. It case, any of such documents furnished by him/her is found to be false at any stage, it would be deemed to be a breach of terms of contract making him/her liable for legal action besides termination of contract/supply order.
- 33. No bidders will be allowed to withdraw after submission of bids/ opening of the tender; otherwise the E.M.D. submitted by the firm would be forfeited.
- 34. Tender rates should be valid upto 31/03/2018 after the date of opening the tender.
- 35. The rate(s) quoted should be strictly for free delivery at office of The Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman and Diu and will be valid and operative for supply orders issued on or before 31/03/2018. The rates should be quoted inclusive of all taxes.
- 36. No other charges such as Octroi, Packing, Forwarding, Freight, Insurance, Loading and Unloading, Clearance and Installation, Entry Tax, Demo, etc. will be allowed. All these are to be borne by the renderer only.
- 37. Security Deposit shall be in any of the forms Fixed Deposit payable to Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman.
- 38.Bid security will be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security.
- 39. Security Deposit will be released after all contractual obligations by the supplier is over. This can be withheld or Forfeited in full or in part in case the supply order is not executed satisfactorily within the stipulated period is not undertaken to the best satisfaction of the competent authority of Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman.
- 40. The Supdt. of Fisheries, Daman reserves the right to relax/ withdraw any of the terms and conditions mentioned above so as to overcome any problem encountered by the contracting parties.
- 41. In the event of acceptance of the tender and placing of the order for purchase the articles ordered would be subjected to an inspection by the Supdt. of Fisheries Daman or its representative and are liable to be rejected if the articles supplied are not confirm to the specifications prescribed.
- 42. The tenders of only those bidders, who have purchased the documents in their names, will be considered.
- 43. The bidder will accept all conditions of the Bid Document unconditionally.
- 44. This bid document is not transferable.
- 45. The firms which have been blacklisted by any Govt. department are not eligible to participate in this tender.

46. These instructions to Tenderers are to be signed by the supplier and returned with the tender.
