**For finalization of Compensation and
Disbursement of claims towards victims of
Natural Calamities and Accident etc. under
NDRF, SDRF and Guidelines of
U. T. Administration.**

1.1 Introduction :-

In the aftermath of disasters the affected people must be looked after for their safety, security and the well being and provided food, water, shelter, clothing, medical care etc. so as to ensure that the affected people live with dignity. State Governments shall be responsible for providing prompt and adequate relief assistance to the victims of Natural Clamities.

1.2 Rescue & Relief :-

During the Disaster and after the Disaster Rescues & Relief work to be carried out on urgent basis by all the Departments like PWD, Police Department, Fire & Emergency Services, Health Department and other key departments alongwith the main ground level teams Chief Officer, Daman Municipal Council, Mamlatdar, Block Development Officer, Superintendent under the Supervision of Collector/District Magistrate, Daman. All line department, Police Local Government Bodies, and NGOs to look after of victims for their safety, security and to provide food, water, shelter, clothing, medical care, financial assistance etc., on priority.

1.3 Inspection and assessment of Losses :-

The Committees for Rural (Panchayat Area) and Urban (Municipal Area) will inspect the site and assess the loss immediately and submitted report within 24 hours of the Damage, To the Collector, Daman/Diu. The detailed report with justification and the estimated cost of loss and with recommendation for financial assistance to the victims will be submitted to Collector/District Magistrate for grant of financial compensation to the victims.

The Committees formed for the assessment of damage and submission of report is their respective jurisdiction :

1.4 Evaluation of Report and Recommendations :-

The Committee constituted by the Collector, Daman vide Order No. COL-DMN/DM-Relief-Victim/2017-18/3911 dated 09/05/2017 will evaluate the amount of financial assistance to be paid to victims. The Committee will submit proposal to Collector/Relief Commissioner to grant financial assistance as per Notifications/Orders/Circulars issued by the Government of India and U.T. Administration of Daman & Diu time to time. The Committee is as under :

1.5 Approval of Financial Assistance :

The proposal to sanction the financial assistance to the victims of natural Calamities will be sent to the Hon'ble Administrator, Daman & Diu with the recommendation of Collector/Relief Commissioner. However, immediate relief as per the NDRF/SDRF U. T. Administration of Daman & Diu norms should be disbursed immediately after the report is received from the team in at 1.3.

1.6 Disbursement of Financial Assistance :-

After the sanction of Financial Assistance the amount shall be drawn by the Collector on Abstract Contingency Bills (AC Bills) quoting the sanction dairy No. and date.

The amount which is to be paid to the victims must be paid by Digital mode only. No cash transaction is permissible.

The Accountant, Collectorate, Daman will disburse the amount and the same shall be credited to the Bank account of Victims.

The "Discretionary Grant Register" must be properly maintained by the Accountant, Collectorate and the same will be attested/counter signed by the Collector, Daman.

NOTICE

WHEREAS, vide Preliminary Notification No. 5/7/COL/LAND-ACQ/2015-16/352/ COLLDMN/2016 dated 17/02/2016, it was Notified under section 11 of the Right to Fair compensation and Transparency in land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, that the land described in the schedule hereto (thereafter referred to as the said land/lands) were needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose, namely for the purpose of **construction of High level Bridge across River Damanganga connecting Zari and Kachigam villages in Daman District.**

WHEREAS, a report was submitted to the Government Authority i.e. Administrator of Daman & Diu for the proceed with acquisition process and the same has been approved by the Appropriate Government i.e. Administrator of Daman & Diu.

WHEREAS, vide Declaration No. 5/7/COL/LAND-ACQ/2015-16/5631 dated 28/06/2017, it was declared under the provision of Section 19 of the Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation Act that the said lands are required for the public purpose, and namely for the purpose of construction of High level Bridge across River Damanganga connecting Zari and Kachigam Villages in Daman District.

WHEREAS, in connection with acquisition of land measuring 21494.00 sq. mtrs. for construction of High level Bridge across River Damanganga connecting Zari and Kachigam Villages in Daman District, the Administration of Daman intends to take possession of the land, the particulars of which are given in the declaration u/s 19 (1) of the Right to Fair compensation & Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement (RFCTLARR) Act, 2013.

WHEREAS, under Section 21 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013, the Government intend to take possession of the land on **20/08/2017 at 10.00 hrs.** and claims to compensations and rehabilitation and resettlement for all interests in the land, has to be submitted to the Collector for disposal on or before **18/08/2017 at 15.00 hrs.**

The details compensation on the land acquisition as per the **Annexure – I, II & III** are enclosed herewith.

WHEREAS, under sub section (1) & (2) of Section 22 of the said Act, the Collector may also require any such person to make or deliver to him a statement containing the name of every other person possessing any interest in the land or any part thereof as co-proprietor, sub-proprietor, mortgage, tenant or otherwise, and of the nature of such interest, and of the rents and profits, if any received or receivable on account thereof for three years next preceding the date of statement, every person required to make or deliver a statement under this section shall be deemed to be legally bound to do so within the meaning of section 175 and 176 of the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860).

- The amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests;
- Their objection if any to the measurements made and marked on the referred area.

ORDER

The prisoners confined in Sub-Jail Diu of Diu District are transferred to Amreli District Jail, Government of Gujarat State with immediate effect, subject to the following conditions :

1. The concerned prisoners must adhere to the Gujarat State Prison Rules. Moreover, the rules of Jail Department of Gujarat State relating to jail security and safety shall be applicable.
2. The undertrail prisoners of Diu District Prison shall be produced before the local court through Video Conferencing System, as far as possible. In exceptional cases, they should be produced before the Court along with police escort party from Diu District. All such expenditure for this production shall be borne by the Daman & Diu Administration.
3. As per the provision of Jail Manual, the proposed expenditure on arrangement of security guards based at jail (salary of guarding staff, allowances etc.) shall also be reimbursed from the Daman & Diu Administration.
4. As per the daily expenditure relating to the prisoners (food, clothing, bedding, water and electricity and building repairing etc.) Rs. 190/- per prisoners, i.e. Rs. 5700/- p.m. and looking to the wages allowances and expenditure of treatment, the applicable amount shall be recovered every month. There is possibility of variation in such expenditure looking to the average expenditure on food and other items. In the event of serious illness, if a Prisoner is referred to a hospital out of headquarter, the total expenditure shall be borne by the Daman & Diu Administration.

5. Payment will be made on the receipt of detailed monthly expenditure submitted to the Daman & Diu Administration by the Prisons Department, Government of Gujarat.

After following the above procedure, the prisoners shall be transferred to the Amreli District Jail immediately.
