**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and with the approval of Union Public Service Commission as conveyed vide letter F.No. 3/33(1)/2019-RR dated 05/11/2020, the Administrator of UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in supersession of all previous Notifications in this behalf do hereby make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Research Officer, Group **B**, (Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Administration namely:-

**1. Short Title and commencement :**

- (i) These rules may be called, the Administration of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Research Officer, Group 'B', (Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) posts Recruitment Rules, 2020.
- (ii) These shall apply to the posts specified in column-1 of the Schedule to these rules.
- (iii) These rules will come into effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette and will relate to appointment to the various posts made on or after this date.

**2. Number of Posts, Classification and Level in the Pay Matrix :-**

The number of the post, classification of the said posts and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Schedule to these rules.

Provided that, the Administrator of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu may vary the number of posts in column 2 of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

**3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc :-**

The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating therewith shall be as specified in column 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule.

**4. Disqualification :-**

No person, (a) who has entered into or contracted marriage with a person having a spouse living or; (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the service.

Provided that the Administrator of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, may, if that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax :-**

Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultaion with UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules wioth respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving :-**

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedules Castes and Scheduled Tribes, and the other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issues by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Preliminary Notification**

Whereas, it appears to the Collector that a total of **4163.74 Sq.mt** of land is required in Silvassa of Dadra and Nagar Haveli for public purpose, namely, **for widening of Silvassa Dandulfalia chowk main road to Umarkui road upto Silvassa Municipal limit**. Social Impact Assessment study was carried out by local SIA Team constituted on 29.08.2020.

2. A total of NIL families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The Resident Deputy Collector (S) is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of Rehabilitation and Resettlement.

3. Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Silvassa of Dadra and Nagar Haveli District the piece of land, whose detail description is enclosed as **Annexure-I** and is also mentioned in the Social Impact Assessment (SIA) report, is under acquisition.
4. This notification is made under the provisions of Section-11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (Act no. 30/2013), to all whom it may concern.
5. A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the District Collector, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa and Resident Deputy Collector(Silvassa), Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa on any working day during the working hours.
6. The Government is pleased to authorize Survey and Settlement Officer(Silvassa) and his staff to enter upon and survey land, take levels of any land, dig or bore into sub-soil & do all other acts required for the proper execution of their work as provided and specified in Section 12 of the said Act.
7. Under section 11(4) of the Act, no person shall make any transaction or cause any transaction of land i.e. sale/purchase, etc., or create any encumbrances on such land from the date of publication of such notification without prior approval of the Collector.
8. Objections to the acquisition, if any, may be filed by the person interested within 60 (Sixty days) from the date of publication of this notification as provided under section 15 of the Act before District Collector.

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**Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Act, 2013 of families affected with the proposed acquisition of land for Improvement of Horizontal Curve on Silvassa-Naroli road between Ch.7/8 to 8/0 km near village Dhapsa.**

**Preface:-**

Vide notification no. LAQ/Horizontal Curve/Road/PWD-II/31/2020/332/2020 Dated 10.12.2020 lands of Naroli village of Dadra and Nagar Haveli were notified u/s 11(1) of The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for Improvement of Horizontal Curve on Silvassa-Naroli road between Ch.7/8 to 8/0 km near village Dhapsa. Vide above mentioned Notification, Resident Deputy Collector(S) is appointed as the Administrator under sub section (1) of Section 43 of the said act for Rehabilitation and Resettlement of affected families due to acquisition for Dadra Nagar Haveli. As per section 16 of RFCTLARR Act 2013, Preparation of Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme by the Administrator should be done and the same is reproduced as below:-

16. Preparation of Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme by the Administrator

1. Upon the publication of the preliminary notification under sub-section(1) of section 11 by the collector, the Administrator for Rehabilitation and Resettlement shall conduct a survey and undertake a census of the affected families, in such manner and within such time as may be prescribed, which shall include —
  - (a) Particulars of lands and immovable properties being acquired of each affected family;
  - (b) Livelihoods lost in respect of land losers and landless whose livelihoods are primarily dependent on the lands being acquired;
  - (c) A list of public utilities and Government buildings which are affected or likely to be affected, where resettlement of affected families is involved;
  - (d) Details of the amenities and infrastructural facilities which are affected or likely to be affected, where resettlement of affected families is involved; and
  - (e) Details of any common property resources being acquired.

2. The Administrator shall, based on the survey and census under sub-section (1), prepare a draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme, as prescribed which shall include particulars of the rehabilitation and resettlement entitlements of each land owner and landless whose livelihoods are primarily dependent on the lands being acquired and where resettlement of affected families is involved —
  - (i) A list of Government buildings to be provided in the Resettlement Area;
  - (ii) Details of the public amenities and infrastructural facilities which are to be provided in the Resettlement Area.
3. The draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement scheme referred to in sub-section (2) shall include time limit for implementing Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme.
4. The draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement scheme referred to in sub-section (2) shall be made known locally by wide publicity in the affected area and discussed in the concerned Gram Sabhas or Municipalities.
5. A public hearing shall be conducted in such manner as may be prescribed, after giving adequate publicity about the date, time and venue for the public hearing at the affected area:

Therefore, the team visited the proposed lands and the details regarding affected families, displaced families, vulnerable person, etc. are collected.

**Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme**

As per chapter VI, Procedure and manner of Rehabilitation and Resettlement-Section 43 of RFCTLARR Act 2013, the undersigned has been appointed as the Administrator for drafting Rehabilitation and Resettlement scheme. This Rehabilitation and Resettlement scheme (R&R scheme) is being drafted in consonance with section 16, 17, 18, 19, 31, 41 & 42 (if applicable), 43, Second Schedule of RFCTLARR Act 2013 and Rules 7, 8, 9 (if applicable) 16, Form IV (if applicable) and Form VII of RFCTLARR (Compensation, Rehabilitation and Resettlement and Development Plan) Rules 2015.

As per the Section 3(k) of RFCTLARR Act 2013, "Displaced Family" means any family who on the account of acquisition of land has to be relocated and resettled from the affected area to the resettlement area. In the present case the land being acquired is Agriculture / Non-Agriculture land for which compensation shall be paid as and when the Collector, Dadra and Nagar Haveli announces the Award. Therefore, it is evident that the affected family may not need relocation and resettlement because they are either not losing their complete house/ land or are left with some land after acquisition or in some cases they are having alternate Residential option. However, I am of the opinion no case for Resettlement is made out for the project affected families. I am of the opinion that the affected families may be considered for Rehabilitation only.

The Rehabilitation & Resettlement Scheme is prepared based on the Second Schedule (ELEMENTS OF REHABILITATION AND RESETTLEMENT ENTITLEMENTS FOR ALL THE AFFECTED FAMILIES (BOTH LAND OWNERS AND THE FAMILIES WHOSE LIVELIHOOD IS PRIMARILY DEPENDENT ON LAND ACQUIRED) IN ADDITION TO THOSE PROVIDED IN THE FIRST SCHEDULE). Based on the second schedule the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme is drafted and summarized in the format (enclosed) and recommended for review by Collector u/s 17 of RFCTLARR Act 2013.
