NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the then Commissioner of Food Safety under Section 30 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 issued Notification in the interest of public health, imposing a complete ban on manufacture, storage, distribution and/or sale of Chewing Tobacco with whatever names it may be known, such as Zarda, Gutkha or Pan Masala containing tobacco and/or nicotine available in the market has been prohibited in the whole UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman & Diu.

2. AND WHEREAS, in the research conducted by various institution, it is observed that, due to consumption of Zarda (Chewing Tobacco) there is high likelihood of developing oral cancer. It is further revealed that chewing of Tobacco leads to oral sub-mucous fibrosis; which is a pre-cancerous condition.

3. AND WHEREAS, Zarda (chewing Tobacco or known by any name) are articles of food which contain tobacco and nicotine as ingredients and consumption of such products is injurious to health and this contravenes the provisions of Regulation 2.3.4 of the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction on Sales) Regulations, 2011.

4. And WHEREAS, with reference to order dtd.03/04/2013 passed by the Hon. Supreme Court, the Ld. Additional Solicitor General invited Court attention to notification issued by the Government of 23 states and the Administrator of 5 Union Territories for imposing complete ban on Gutkha and Pan Masala with Tobacco and/or nicotine and then stated that notwithstanding the ban, the manufacturers have densed a subterfuge for selling Gutkha and Pan Masala in separate pouches and in

this manner the ban is being flouted and thereafter, Hon'ble Court has passed order to issue notification in term of 2006 Act in respect of total compliance of ban imposed on manufacturing and sale of Gutkha and Pan Masala with tobacco and/or nicotine.

5. NOW THEREFORE, **the Secretary Health/ Commissioner of Food Safety**, UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (2) of Section 30 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (Act No.34 of 2006), in the interest of public health, hereby impose a complete ban on manufacture, storage, distribution or sale of Chewing Tobacco with whatever names it may be known, such as Zarda, Gutkha or Pan Masala containing tobacco and/or nicotine as an ingredient with final product available in the market, in the whole UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu for a further period w.e.f. 30/11/2021 to 29/11/2022.

NOTICE

WHEREAS, vide Preliminary Notification No.3/87/LND-ACQ/2020-21/2950 dated 10/06/2021, it was Notified under section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, that the land described in the schedule hereto (hereafter referred to as the said land/lands) were needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose, namely for the purpose of **Acquisition of land for Construction of New School Building for Government School, Kachigam, Nani Daman.**

WHEREAS, a report was submitted to the Government Authority i.e. Administrator of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu for the proceed with the acquisition process and the same has been approved by the Appropriate Government i.e. Administrator of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.

WHEREAS, vide **Declaration** No.3/87/LND-ACQ/2020-21/3104 dated 05/07/2022, it was declared under the provision of Section 19 of the Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation Act that the said lands are required for the public purpose, and namely for the purpose of **Acquisition of land for Construction of New School Building for Government School, Kachigam, Nani Daman.**

WHEREAS, in connection with acquisition of land admeasuring **1229.00 sq. mtrs.** for **Acquisition of land for Construction of New School Building for Government School, Kachigam, Nani Daman**, the Administration of Daman intends to take possession of the land, the particulars of which are given in the declaration u/s 19(1) of the Right to Fair compensation & Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement (RFCTLARR) Act, 2013.

WHEREAS, under Section 21 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013, the Government intend to take possession of the land on 26/08/2022 at 10.00 hrs., and claims to compensations and rehabilitation and resettlement for all interests in the land, has to be submitted to the Collector for disposal on or before 18/08/2022 at 15.00 hrs.

The details compensation on the land acquisition as per the Annexure – I, II & III are enclosed herewith.

WHEREAS, under sub section (1) & (2) of Section 22 of the said Act, the Collector may also require any such person to make or deliver to him a statement containing the name of every other person possessing any interest in the land or any part thereof as co-proprietor, sub-proprietor, mortgage, tenant or otherwise, and of the nature of such interest, and of the rents and profits, if any received or receivable on account thereof for three years next preceding the date of statement, every

person required to make or deliver a statement under this section shall be deemed to be legally bound to do so within the meaning of section 175 and 176 of the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860).

NOW THEREFORE, to facilitate causation of the above requirements, public notice is hereby served under section 21 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 that all persons having interest in the said land to appear personally or by agent or advocate before the Collector, Daman on **24/08/2022** at **11:30 A.M.** and to state in writing and signed by the party or his agent, the following :

- a) The nature of their respective interest in their land;
- b) The amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests;
- c) Their objection if any to the measurements made and marked on the referred area.

Please take notice that as provided under sub-section 22 of the aforesaid Act, every person required to make or deliver a statement under this section shall be deemed to be legally bound to do so within the meaning of sections 175 and 178 of the Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860).
