**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso under article 309 of the Constitution, the Administrator hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment, terms and conditions of the various posts in the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu namely: -

**1.Short title and commencement-**

- (a) These rules may be called the Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Services Rules, 2022.
- (b) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Definitions:** -In these rules, unless the context otherwise require: -

- (a) "Administrator" means the Administrator of Union Territory of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu appointed by the President under Article 239 of the Constitution;
- (b) "Administration" means the U.T. Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu;
- (c) "Controlling Authority" means the Administrator of U.T. Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu;
- (d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee specified in Schedule III

for considering cases of promotion or confirmation in Group 'A' posts of the Service;

- (e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a Group 'A' Departmental Selection Committee specified in **Schedule III** for selection in Group 'A' posts of the Service;
- (f) "Duty Post" means any post, whether permanent or temporary, specified in **Schedule II**;
- (g) "Dynamic Assured Career Progression Scheme" means the scheme formulated by the Controlling Authority for time bound promotion of the officers of the Service without taking into account the vacancies, on such terms and conditions as may be specified by the Central Government from time to time;
- (h) "Grade" means any of the grades specified in **Schedule I**;
- (i) "Schedule" means a Schedule to these rules;
- (j) "Schedule Castes" and "Schedule Tribes" shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in clauses (24) and (25) of Article 366 of the Constitution;
- (k) "Service" means Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Service;
- (l) "Sub-Cadre" means any of streams of the Service, namely, Administrative Cadre/Teaching Cadre/Non- Teaching Cadre/ General Duty Medical Officer/Others

**3. Composition of the Service-** All duty posts, included in the Service shall be classified as (Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Service Rules, 2022) Group 'A' and the Grades, Pay Band, Grade Pay or Pay Scale, non-practicing allowance and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in **Schedule-I**.

**4. Authorized strength of the Service-**

- (a) The authorized strength of the duty posts included in the various grades of the Service on the date of commencement of these rules shall be as specified in **Schedule-II**.
- (b) After the commencement of these rules, the authorized permanent strength of the duty posts in the various grades shall be such as may, from time to time, be determined by the Administration.
- (c) The Administration may make temporary addition to, or reduction in, the strength of the duty posts in the various grades as deemed necessary from time to time.
- (d) The Administration may, in consultation with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) or Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India wherever applicable include in the Service any post other than those included in **Schedule-II** or exclude from the service a post included in the said Schedule.
- (e) The Administration may, in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) or Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India wherever applicable appoint an officer whose post is included in the Service, to the appropriate grade of the Service in a temporary capacity or in a substantive capacity, as may be deemed fit, and fix his



seniority in the grade after taking into account continuous regular service in the analogous grade.

#### **5. Members of the Service -**

A person appointed under Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Services shall, be the Member of the Service in the appropriate grade applicable to him in **Schedule-I** from the date of such appointment.

#### **6. Future Maintenance of Service-**

(a) The vacancies in any of the grades referred to in **Schedule-II**, shall be filled in the manner as hereinafter provided under these rules.

(b) The method of recruitment, the field of selection for promotion, including the minimum qualifying service in the immediate lower grade or lower grades as the case may be, for appointment or promotion to the posts in the respective Sub-Cadre and specialties within the Sub-cadre concerned, included in the Service shall be specified in **Schedule-III**.

(c) (i) The departmental promotions up to Senior Administrative Grade level shall be made as specified in **Schedule-III** without taking into account the vacancies and shall be confined to officers of respective Sub-Cadre on the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee as specified in **Schedule-III**.

(ii) The promotion to post of Chief Medical Officer shall be made by selection amongst the Senior Medical Officer.

(iii) The promotion to post of Additional Medical Superintendent of teaching institute shall be made by selection from the Teaching Specialist Cadre and for the Non-Teaching institutions; the selection shall be made from Non-Teaching Specialist/GDMO cadre

(iv) The promotion to post of Director (Medical & Health Services) shall be made by selection on the basis of combined eligibility list of Senior Administrative Grade officers belonging to all Sub-Cadres of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Service Rules.

(v) If an officer appointed in the following Sub-Cadres- Teaching Specialist/ Non-Teaching Specialist/ GDMO in the Service is considered for the purpose of promotion to the Director (Medical & Health Services) post, all persons in the seniority grade of the respective Sub-Cadre or in the respective Specialty of the Sub-cadre, as the case may be, shall also be considered, provided, they are not short of requisite qualifying or eligible service and have completed their probation period, if specified.

(vi) The combined eligibility list referred to in clause (iv) shall be prepared with reference to the dates of completion of the number of years of service by the officers in the Senior Administrative Grade:

Provided that, for the purposes of preparing the combined eligibility list, the seniority of officers in the Senior Administrative Grade shall be determined as under, namely:-

- (i) The seniority of persons in the concerned specialty and Sub-Cadre shall be on the basis of seniority in the feeder grade.
  - (ii) If there is no seniority in the feeder grade or it is not possible to determine the seniority even in the feeder grade, the length of the regular service in the feeder grade shall be the guiding factor for determining the seniority.
  - (iii) If length of service in the feeder grade is also the same, regular service in the next lower grade shall be taken into account, failing which, the date of birth.
- (d) The minimum benchmark required for promotion to various grades of the Service and the benchmarks under the Dynamic Assured Career Progression Scheme shall be as specified in **Schedule-VI**.
- (e) Except while appointing a serving officer on non-selection basis (seniority-cum fitness), the selection of officers for maintenance of the Service and wherever necessary, on the basis of the recommendation made by the Departmental Promotion Committee as specified in **Schedule-III**.
- (f) The minimum educational and other qualification, experience and age limit for appointment to various duty posts in the Service by direct recruitment shall be as specified in **Schedule-IV**.
- (g) The recognized post-graduate qualifications required for recruitment to various posts included in the service shall be as specified in **Schedule V**.

**Note 1:** All the posts upto the level of Senior Administrative Grade in all the Sub-Cadres are inter changeable within their respective sub-

cadres for the purpose of promotion under the Dynamic Assured Career Progression Scheme.

**Note 2:** The promotion to various grades of the Service upto Senior Administrative Grade Level, other than entry grades, shall be without taking into account the vacancies.

**7. (a) Seniority:** -The relative seniority of members of the Service appointed to a grade in the respective Sub-Cadres or in the respective specialty of the Sub-Cadre of the Service, as the case may be, on the date of commencement of these rules shall be as determined by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu:

Provided that, if the seniority of any such member had not been specifically determined on the said date, the same shall be determined on the basis of the rules governing the fixation of seniority as were applicable to the members of the Service prior to the commencement of these rules.

(b) The seniority of the officers appointed to the Service other than those appointed under rule 5 shall be determined in accordance with the general instructions issued by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in the matter from time to time.

(c) The seniority of a person in all the Sub-cadres who are promoted to the posts up to the level of Senior Administrative Grade shall be same as the relative seniority in the lower grade within Sub-Cadre from which they are promoted:

Provided that, in the case of person found 'unfit' for time bound promotion, their seniority shall be determined with

reference to the date of actual promotion at each level in each Sub-Cadre.

(d) In cases not covered by this rule, seniority shall be determined by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

**8. (a) Probation-** Every officer appointed to the Service by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a period of two years.

Provided further that, the Controlling Authority may extend the period of probation in accordance with the instructions issued by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu from time to time in this behalf.

Provided also that, any decision for extension of the period of probation of an officer shall be taken immediately after the expiry of initial period of probation and ordinarily within eight weeks and communicated in writing to the concerned officer together with the reasons for so doing with the said period.

(b) On completion of the period of probation or any extension thereof, officer shall, if considered fit for permanent appointment, be confirmed in terms of the extent order of the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.

(c) If, during the period of probation or any extension thereof, as the case may be, U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu is of the opinion that an officer is not fit for permanent appointment, U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu may discharge the officer or revert him

to the post held by him prior to his appointment in the Service, as the case may be.

(d) During the period of probation or any extension thereof, officers may be required by the UT Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu to undergo such courses of training or to pass such examinations or tests including examinations in regional language as the UT Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu may deem fit as condition for satisfactory completion of probation.

(e) The other matters relating to probation of members of the service shall be governed by the orders or instructions issued by the UT Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in this regard from time to time.

**9. Appointment in the service.** All appointments to the Service shall be made by the Controlling Authority.

**10. Posting.** - Officers appointed to the Service shall be liable to serve anywhere in UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.

**11. Private practice prohibited. –**

(a) Persons appointed to the service shall not be allowed private practice of any kind whatsoever including any consultation and laboratory practice.

(b) The members of the Service, who are registered with the National Medical Commission or State Medical Council as Medical Practitioners, shall be entitled to a non-practicing allowance at the rates specified in **Schedule-I**

**12. Other conditions of Service.** - The condition of Service of the members of the Service in respect of matters not expressly provided for in these rules, shall, mutatis mutandis and subject to any special orders issued by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in respect of the Service, be the same as those applicable to officers of the Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Health Service Rules in general.

**13. Disqualification.** – No Person: -

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to the Service:

Provided that, the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**14. Power to relax.** - Where the Ministry of Health or Family Welfare (MoHFW) and Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India wherever applicable is of the **opinion** that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order, for reasons to be recording in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**15. Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the other Backward Classes,

the Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders Issued by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu from time to time in this regard.

**16. Interpretation.** -If any question relating to the interpretation of these rules arises, it shall be decided by the U.T Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

**(II- Rate of Non-Practicing Allowance)** – The Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu Service Officers shall be entitled to Non-Practicing

Allowance at such rates as may be decided by the Government of India from time to time.

**(III- Post Graduate Allowance)** – A medical graduate appointed to the post of Medical Officer or Senior Medical Officers or Chief Medical Officer including Chief Medical Officer (Non-functional Selection Grade), for which a recognized post graduate qualification is not essential, shall be given over and above pay admissible in the relevant scale, Post Graduate Allowance of Rs.600 per month or Rs. 1000 per month, as the case may be, for possessing recognized Post Graduate Diploma or Post Graduate degree respectively, as specified in Schedule V or under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956):

Provided that if an officer possesses both the recognized Post Graduate Diploma and Degree, he shall be paid the non-practicing allowance of Rs. 1000 only.

**Note.** - The rates of the Non-Practicing Allowance and Post Graduate Allowance shall be governed by the instructions issued by the Government on the subject from time to time.

**(IV- Allowances for Teaching Cadre)  
Learning Resource Allowance (LRA)**

A faculty appointed under Teaching Institute shall be eligible to reimburse Rs 1,50,000 learning resource allowance per year. The reimbursement is permissible for the items under the categories of Clinical Materials, Research Materials, Academic Materials, CME, Workshop, Conferences, Fellowship courses.
