# Achievements of U.T. Plan Schemes and Centrally Sponsored Schemes:

#### (A) U. T. PLAN SCHEMES:

## U. T. Administration is providing assistance to Fishermen through the following Plan Schemes:-

## 1) <u>ASSISTANCE TO THE FISHERMEN FOR PURCHASE OF FISHERIES</u> REQUISITES:

This scheme is being implemented prior to de-linking from Goa. Under the Scheme, financial assistance in the form of 70% Loan and 20%Subsidy (maximum ceiling of cost of item is Rs. 1.00 lakh) is being provided to fishermen for purchase of Fibre Cannoe, Nets, Plastics Floats, Ropes, Ice boxes, and electronic equipments like V.H.Fs, Fish finders, G.P.S. etc. 10% cost of the item is borne by the beneficiaries.

Recovery terms of Govt. Loan.:

The beneficiary has to repay the loan amount within a period of seven year in 21 equal quarterly installments along with the 13.5% yearly interest.

#### (B). PLAN SCHEMES UNDER DISTRICT PANCHAYAT.

# 1) <u>FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FAMILIES OF THE FISHERMEN</u> CAPTURED BY PAKISTANI MARINE SECURITY AGENCY (PMSA):

- This scheme is being implemented since 2004-05. Under this Scheme, one time financial assistance of Rs. 50,000/- is provided to the families of the fishermen who are shot dead by Pakistani Marine Security Agency (PMSA), or died during captivity in Pakistani jail.
- In other cases, assistance @ 50 Rs. per day/per fishermen who are apprehended by PMSA and lodged in Pakistani jails is provided to the family of fishermen. The fishermen should be resident of UT of Daman and Diu. However the fishermen who are captured more than once are not eligible for this assistance. Following are the details of assistance provided, under the Scheme:

# 2) <u>SUPPLY OF INSULATED ICEBOXES AND DISPLAY BOXES TO THE FISHERWOMEN.</u>

This Scheme is being implemented since 2008-09. Under this scheme, financial assistance to the fisherwomen for purchase of Insulated ice boxes & display boxes along with transparent lids, in the form of 75% subsidy maximum up to Rs. 5,000/- per Fisher women and 25% of the cost of item is being borne by the beneficiaries is provided.

# 3) <u>FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING THE</u> FISHING VESSEL DURING MONSOON SEASON.

This scheme is being implemented since 2006-07. In order to assist the fishermen in bearing the cost on loading of fishing vessels from sea before monsoon and for unloading of fishing vessels from fishing jetty after the monsoon, financial assistance is being provided to the boat owners in the form of 50 % back ended subsidy maximum upto Rs. 2,500/-. Details of assistance provided to the fishermen are as following:

Under this Plan Scheme 100% financial assistance in the form of Subsidy maximum upto Rs. 8,000/- is provided for establishment of marine/freshwater ornamental fish aquarium.

#### 1) GROUP ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR ACTIVE FISHERMEN:

This Scheme is implemented from 1997-98. Under this scheme, all the active fishermen / fisherwomen of Daman and Diu have been covered. They have been insured for a sum of Rs.1, 00,000/- for death and Rs. 50,000/- for partial disability. 100% annual premium is being borne by the Government of India. Details of assistance provided are as below:

#### 2) FISHERMEN DEVELOPMENT REBATE ON HSD OIL:

This Scheme is implemented from 1990-91. Under this Scheme Sales tax /Vat free Diesel is being provided to the registered Boat owners of Daman and Diu up to the admissible limit of:

11000 liters per year for the Boats having engine below 50 H.P. capacity, 16000 liters per year for the Boats having engine between 51 - 100 H.P. Capacity, and 24,000 liters per year for the Boats having engine above 100 H.P. Capacity.

Further, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, Rebate on HSD Oil @ Rs. 1.50 /per litre is also being provided to the Boat Owners. Details of assistance provided are as below:

#### 3) DEVELOPMENT OF MODEL FISHERMEN VILLAGES:

This Scheme is implemented from 1998-99. Under this scheme, 100% financial assistance maximum up to Rs. 40,000/- (now Rs.50, 000/-w.e.f. 2009-10) is being provided to fishermen for Construction of houses on Govt land / their own land.

Details of assistance provided are as follows:

- In the year 1998-99 100 nos of houses were constructed in Vanakbara Diu on the Govt. land.
- In the year 1999-2000 50 nos of houses were constructed in Ghoghal Diu on the Govt. land.
- Due to the constrain/shortage of Govt. land in Daman, with the approval of the GOI, this scheme has been extended to the fishermen having own land or kutchha construction.

#### <u>4) MOTORISATION OF TRADITIONAL CRAFT:</u>

This Scheme is implemented from 2005-06. Under this centrally sponsored Scheme, 50% financial assistance maximum upto Rs.30,000/- is provided to the small boat owners for purchase of outboard/inboard engine (8-10 H.P). 50 % cost is borne by the beneficiary. Details of assistance provided are as below:

#### 5) SAFETY OF FISHERMEN AT SEA :-

Under this Centrally Sponsored Scheme, financial assistance in the form of 75 % of unit cost of kit (maximum upto Rs 1.5 Lakh) consisting of GPS, Communication equipment, echo sounder and Search & rescue beacon is provided by the Govt. of India.

Against the proposal of Rs.225.00 lakhs for 200 nos of beneficiaries, Govt. of India has sanctioned Rs.50.00 lakhs as a first installment. In the financial year 2011-12 85 fishermen of Daman and Diu have been sanctioned subsidy amount of Rs. 45.70 lakhs for purchase of GPS & VHF etc/for an amount of Rs. 39.50 is under submittion.

#### 6) <u>INTRODUCTION OF INTERMEDIATE CRAFT OF IMPROVED</u> <u>DESIGN:-</u>

Under this Centrally Sponsored Scheme, financial assistance in the form of 10 % subsidy (maximum up to Rs.6.00 lakhs) is provided for construction of intermediate class of fishing vessels of below 18 mtrs length capable of doing multi day fishing.

Against the proposal of Rs.30.00 lakhs, for 05 nos of beneficiaries. Govt. of India has sanctioned Rs.15.00 lakhs as a first installment during the year 2009-10. In the year 2010-11 fund of Rs. 15.00 lakh was utilized for 3 beneficaries.
