## P R E S S - N O T E

This UT Administration of Daman & Diu had invited applications for the post of Lower Division Clerk vide Advertisement No.1/103/89-Per/Vol.II/384 dated 20/06/2008 and Advertisement No. 1/103/89-Per/Vol.II/738 dated 13/08/2010 and had conducted written test for the post of Lower Division Clerk on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2010 at 3.00 p.m. at MGM Sarvajanic Vidhyalay, Khariwad, Nani Daman.

Total 1038 applicants were issued call letters for written test for the said posts. Out of 1038 candidates 754 number of candidates appeared for the written test. Based on the merit of the candidates in written test, 156 candidates were called for the Computer Skill Test and oral interview.

Oral interview was held on 16/12/2010 and 18/12/2010. Computer Skill Test was conducted on 14/12/2010, wherein only 25 candidates had qualified / attained the required speed of 35 w.p.m. Since 28 number of posts of L.D.C. were required to be filled-in and only 25 candidates were available against 28 posts. So the Administration had therefore conducted Computer Skill Test on 26/12/2010, with the prior approval of Administrator, Daman & Diu. In the second attempt only 09 candidates could attain the speed of 35 w.p.m. or more in the Computer Skill Test. On the whole only 34 candidates had qualified the Computer Skill Test.

The DSC felt that many bright and intelligent candidates were not coming in the zone of consideration just because they had not cleared the Computer Skill Test, which is an essential clause of the R.R. for the post of L.D.C. Therefore, the DSC decided that one more chance should be given to all the candidates who could not clear the Computer Skill Test so as to enable the DSC to select the right and eligible candidates for the post of L.D.C. Accordingly a Computer Skill Test was held with the prior approval of Administrator, Daman and Diu for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time on 27/02/2011. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> attempt only 17 candidates could attain the speed of 35 w.p.m. or more in the Computer Skill Test and the




total number of candidates who had cleared the Computer Skill Test has raised to 50 candidates.

Out of 50 candidates, 21 candidates were daily wages / contract basis employees working in various departments of Daman & Diu.

The issue regarding regularization of Daily wages Teachers in Daman and Diu was discussed in the inter ministerial meeting taken by the Home Secretary on 15/07/2010 and it was decided to relax age for person working on daily wages or contract basis continuously and without break for atleast for one year and 6 months as on 31/05/2010 so as to enable them to apply against the advertisements issued for direct recruitment. Subsequently the Ministry of Human Resource Development also approved the proposal of one time relaxation in age of the aforesaid daily wages / contract basis employee.

In view of the decision taken in the case of teachers, it was proposed to extend the same to other post also. The UT Administration Daman & Diu have issued advertisement for filling up of vacant post of LDCs and some other posts Accordingly UT Administration of Daman & Diu had decided to allow one time relaxation in age to daily wages / contract employees who have worked atleast one and half year continuously and without break for appearing in the recruitment process, subject to the condition that the employee was within the prescribed age limit and possessed the requisite education qualifications as per the Recruitment Rules at the time of their initial appointment.

In view of above, the Administration of Daman and Diu vide its Circular No.6/14/94-Per/1068 dated 01/10/2010 had considered to relax upper age limit for person working on daily wages or contract basis continuously and without break for atleast one year and six months as on 31/05/2010 so as to enable them to apply against the advertisement issued for direct recruitment. Thereafter vide Circular No.6/14/08-Per/1073 dated 01/10/2010 all head of office of Daman and Diu were requested to forward the application from the daily wages / contract basis working under their control who have worked for atleast one and half year continuously and without break for appearing in the recruitment process.





Accordingly applications were received from daily wages / contract basis employees of the Administration and were given chance to participate in the interview process.. That 21 employees / candidates working on daily wages / contract basis working in various department's of the Administration had qualified in the written test and Computer Skill Test. The DSC on the basis of the performance of the candidates in the Written Test, Computer Skill Test and Oral interview and their experience in service, and also keeping in mind the judgment passed by a Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal Nos.3535-3612/1999 etc., in the case of Secretary, State of Karnataka and others Vs Uma Devi and others and DOPT's O.M. No.49019/1/2006-Estt.(C) dated 11/12/2006, recommends the name of the following candidate in the order of their merit in the select list :-
