#### NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 103 of the Daman and Diu Value Added Tax Regulation, 2005 (1 of 2005) (hereafter referred to as the said Regulation), the Government hereby otherwise amends the First, Third, Forth, Fifth and Sixth Schedules to the said Regulation in the following manner, namely:-
