

01	Poultry & Emu Demonstrations Farm Year of the Project (2008-09)	<p>The scheme is introduced to replace low productive indigenous Poultry birds with improved germ plasma of Genetically improved Deshi breed derived by using Genetics Science. This will improve growth rate, and prevents early mortality, gives good growth in short period. This scheme besides improving Poultry breed for meat and Egg production will also help the farmers.</p> <p><i>Emu farming is a new concept in India, and has good prospects. Emu are sturdy birds and able to accommodate any kind of climates.</i></p> <p>This scheme has been introduced for up-gradation of local Deshi breeds as well as to produce entrepreneur in village area, so the unemployed youth can generate livelihood by establishing small scale Poultry farming.</p>	For the benefits of Farmers of Daman District, the grown adult live poultry birds are sold to the farmer's for their back yard poultry. This newly introduced birds will improve the quality of local breed. Annually we are selling 2500 to 3000 birds in Daman District.
02	Dairy Demonstration Farm Year of the Project (2009-10)	At Dairy Demonstration Farm, we were keeping Cattle of Indigenous as well as exotic breed for rearing, milk production and the main motive is Demonstration. By visiting this farm, a farmer and small entrepreneur can establish their own farm on scientific manner. In the present farm, we started rearing of Cows & Buffaloes. The Cattle will be much useful because this animal requires good maintenance, quality feed and can suffice the milk supply to a small and poor farmer/ owner. Dairying is an important source of subsidiary income to small/marginal farmers and agricultural laborers. The manure from animals provides a good source of organic matter for improving soil fertility and crop yields.	After visiting the farm which runs on scientific manner, a farmer can start following same method for rearing of his / her animal at their Home. By cross-breeding we introduce good germ-plasma into Local breeds, thus increase milk production as well as disease resistant capacity of animal



03	Integrated Dairy Development Project (IDDP) Year if the Project (2010-11)	Milch animals comprising of crossbreed cows shall be given to beneficiary families. The Valsad District Co-operative Milk Producers' Union Limited, popularly known as Vasudhara Dairy will be assisted with the UT Administration of Daman & Diu through the Co-operative Department and Animal Husbandry Department in implementation of the project. The identified beneficiaries will be encouraged to form Dairy co-operatives. Co-operatives will be the nodal point for delivery of milk by the beneficiaries and collection point by the apex body. A "Dudh Ghar" will be constructed for each society which apart from being the collection point will also facilitate day to day business like testing, weighing of milk, distribution of fodder, etc.	U.T. Administration provides subsidy maximum upto 50% on bank loan of Rs. 25,000/- per beneficiary. A subsidy is also provided for purchase of various implement like chaff cutter, Utensils and to construct cattle sheds.
