

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of May 2015)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of May, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of May, 2015:

- Providing 40mm thick dense graded bituminous macadam and 20mm thick mix seal surface (MSS type) by sencer paver finish on four lane road from Nagoa junction to Vanakbara, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 2.77 Crore.**
- Construction of protection wall with pathway along seashore of Nagoa beach from opp. Police station to Entrance gate near Canga Sagar at Nagoa, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.45 Crore.**
- Providing of Furnishing items to the Govt. Circuit House, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.21 Crore.**

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of May, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of May, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to 13 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

Provided 266 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg base to 29 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Agriculture**

One day training Programme has organized on "Paddy Cultivation" at Priari School Ground, Moti Daman.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **7214** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1626** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1324** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **230** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 25.65 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST** boy students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 25.22 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST** girl students.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

Pension released to **10,825** Old Age pensioners, **Widows** pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of May, 2015:

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- The Bal Bhavan students participated in Chess Championship organised at Navsari-Gujarat on 3rd May, 2015.
- Summer Camp has been organised from 5th to 28th May, 2015 at Bal Bhavan, Daman. 175 children participated in creative writing, art & craft, music and dance, yoga, painting, drama etc.
- World Environmental Day was organised on 25th May, 2015 at Bal Bhavan, Daman. 65 children participated in the poster competition.

➤ **Sports**

- Daman District Open Football Tournament 2015-16 was organised from 21st May to 30th May, 2015 at Football Ground, Moti Daman. Total 08 teams were participated in this Football Tournament.

- Daman District Open Table Tennis Tournament 2015-16 was organised from 29th to 30th May, 2015 at Technical Institute, Moti Daman.

➤ **Fire**

Fire safety training was given to 41 workers and staff of M/s. Jhunkam Lighting System P. Ltd., Kachigam on 22nd June, 2015.

D. Other Important Activity (in brief):

- Cleanliness Drive was organised on the occasion of Labour Day i.e. 1st May, 2015. The Public Representative, Leader of Local Bodies, Govt. Officers has participated in the Cleanliness Drive under the Leadership of Hon'ble Administrator.
- Social Security Schemes namely **Pradhan Mantri Surksha Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jivan Bima Yojana and Atal Pension Yojana** were launched on 9th May, 2015 at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium by the Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Tribal Affairs, Shri Mansukhbhai Vasava in presence of Hon'ble Administrator, Hon'ble Member of Parliament and other signatories.
- The Progress status of Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana was reviewed by the Collector, Daman on 6th May, 2015.
- The Hon'ble Administrator has visited Diu along with Development Commissioner and Secretary, Tourism from 10th May to 12th May, 2015 and reviewed the progress status of various Infrastructural Development Projects of Diu.
