

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of July 2015)**

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of July, 2015 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) Major Works completed during the month of July, 2015:**

- Widening of road at Vanagia- Fudam, Diu at the cost of Rs.58,00,000.
- Strengthening, repairs and rehabilitation and restoration of city wall from Diu Zampa to Chandrikamata Temple at Diu at the cost of Rs.2,53,00,000.
- Diversion of existing 66KV D/C Una-Diu Transmission line to nearby area at Dangerwadi village in Diu.

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of July, 2015:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of July, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Tractors facility has been provided to 23 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Agriculture**

- Soil sample analysis report of Zari village, Moti Daman has been received.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **6131** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1514** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1324** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **230** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **11,027 Old Age** pensioners, **Widows** pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Technical Training Institute**

- Stipend of Rs.71,000/- has been disbursed to 71 SC/ST trainees under TSP scheme.

**C. Organisation of important Events during the month of July, 2015:**

- Jan Sunvai Programme has been organized at Zari Community Hall on 04<sup>th</sup> July, 2015. The issues related with Health, Education, Electricity, Infrastructural Development, Water Supply etc. were raised by the villagers and the officer concerned assured the villagers to solve the issues related with their department.
- The World Population Day was celebrated on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 at Primary Health Centre, Kachigam. The Hon'ble Member Parliament was the chief guest in the function.
- Community Awareness programme on Pradhanmantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhanmantri Jeevan Bima Yojana, Pradhanmantri Suraksha Bima Yojana and Atal Pension Yojana were organized at Varkund Group Gram Panchayat, Nani Daman on 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.
- **Digital India Week – 2015**
  - 'Saral Seva Kendra' was inaugurated at Pariari, Bhimpore and Kachigam Gram Panchayat, Daman during Digital India Week on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2015 by the Hon'ble Administrator and in presence of Hon'ble Member of Parliament and other dignitaries. The Services like electricity bill payment, mobile recharges and payments, DTH recharges, Data Card recharges, LIC premiums, Aadhaar Card copies, Rail Air and bus tickets, Pan Card and passport application, etc. will be available at this Saral Seva Kendra. The service of **Wi-Fi** facility was also inaugurated by the Hon'ble Administrator on the same day at Adarsh Gram - Pariari, Moti Daman.

- ‘SaralSeva Kendra’ at Vanakbara village, Diu was inaugurated by Collector, Diu on 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.
- Diu Tourism Mobile App was inaugurated by Collector, Diu at Conference Hall, Collectorate, Diu on 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.
- A training program on basic computer literacy has been organized for Anganwadi workers & shop keepers of public distribution system under Digital literacy Campaign. Total 38 dealers & 59 Anganwadi Workers had participated in the training program at Government High School, Moti Daman.

➤ **Health**

- A training program has been organized on “PentaValentVaccination” on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 by Directorate of Medical & Health Services. Health workers were trained and sensitized for the use of PentaValent Vaccination by Dr. ChintanValia of World Health Organization. This vaccination will help the children to fight diseases like Diphtheria, Tetanus, Hepatitis, etc.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- 40 children of Bal Bhavan Board, Diu participated in “Craft Making&Warli Painting Workshop’ from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 to 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.
- ‘Cloth Bag Making Workshop’ was organised from 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 to 18<sup>th</sup> July 2015 at Bal Bhavan Board, Diu. Total 26 Students had participated in the workshop.

➤ **Sports**

- Daman district Inter School Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament – 2015 was organized from 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 for Sub- junior Boys (U- 14) and Junior Boys (U-17). Total 16 teams had participated in the tournament.

➤ **Fire**

- Basic Fire Safety training has been given inGovernment Primary Schools of Nailapardi, Jampore and Pariyari, Moti Daman from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 to 3<sup>rd</sup>July, 2015.

#### **D. Other Important Activity (in brief):**

- The 124 Police Personnel were inducted under Police Department after completion of training. The parade function was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 at Police Head Quarters in which Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu has inspected the parade.
- The Development Commissioner visited the Birth & Death registration office of Daman Municipal Council, Mamlatdar office and Superintendent of Police office, Nani Daman Police Station along with Collector, Deputy Collector, Daman and Additional Chief Registrar (RBD). The issues related with late registration, corrections were reviewed and necessary directions were issued to the concerned.
- The Bhimpore Gram Panchayat has organized Cleanliness Campaign on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 in Panchayat areas under the leadership of Sarpanch&Jilla Panchayat members.
- **National Population Register (NPR)**
  - The U.T. Administration of Daman & Diu has started updation& enrollment under National Population Register (NPR) from 31<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.
  - A training program of Enumerators engaged for National Population Register related works was organized on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium, Nani Daman.
- **C.I.F.B.**
  - A system of Self Certification under the labour laws has been introduced.
  - Third party inspection for boilers has been notified.
- **Industries**
  - The scheme "Investment Promotion Schemes – 2015 (IPS – 2015)" has been introduced for MSMEs, Textile & Skill Development Institute to strengthen and make them globally competitive containing details of eligibility criteria, quantum of incentives and monitoring mechanism for administering the incentives.
