

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of April 2015)**

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of April, 2015 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) Major Works completed during the month of April, 2015:**

- Providing Concertina Coil fence on Airport compound wall at Nagoa, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.45 Crore.**
- Addition and alteration to the existing Incinerator Room including construction of a Hall on first floor at CHC, Ghoghla, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.42 Crore.**
- Strengthening, Widening and Re-Carpeting of existing road starting from M.D.R. Bird Watching tower at Fudam, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.34 Crore.**
- Development & Beautification of Coastal Highway Road Junction at Bamanpuja, Moti Daman has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.25 Crore.**
- Supplying, Erecting, testing and commissioning of 200 KVA silent D.G.set with standard Panel/AMF Panel and cabling, erecting etc. of D.G. set at C.H.C., Ghoghla, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.25 Crore.**
- Providing and Establishment of smart class rooms for Diu College at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.17 Crore.**

**(ii) Infrastructural Projects inaugurated:**

- **The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated Workshop Building** at Daman Polytechnic on 25th April, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 3.68 Crore.**
- **The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated Central Store Building** of Electricity Department at Kachigam on 25th April, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 2.54 Crore.**
- **The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated Pipe Water Supply scheme on Kalai River,** Daman on 25th April, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 1.89 Crore.**
- **The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated AYUSH Hospital and Panch Karma Centre at PHC,** Kachigam on 25th April, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 1.67 Crore.**

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of April, 2015:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of April, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to **05 farmers** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about 13,341 students (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Health**

Financial assistance released of Rs.35,000/-to 7 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **7214** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1626** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1320** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **230** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

Pension released to **10,821** Old Age pensioners, **Widows** pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

**C. Organisation of important Events during the month of April, 2015:**

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- Children of Bal Bhavan, Daman had participated in “**Open Maharashtra Karate Championship**” at Mumbai on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 and awarded with 2 Gold Medals, 2 Silver Medals and 1 Bronze Medal.
- Children of Bal Bhavan, Daman had participated in “**Beti Bachao- Beti Padhao**” National campaign programme at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium on 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2015. About 50 children participated in activities such as Song, Karate show, Drama & Dance.

➤ **Sports**

- Summer Coaching Camp- 2015-16 were organised for disciplines like Football, Badminton, Lawn Tennis, Swimming, Judo, Table Tennis, Athletics, Cricket at Kho-Kho from 16<sup>th</sup> April to 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 at Football Ground, Moti Daman.
- Special Judo Camp was organised for Girls from 20<sup>th</sup> April to 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Kachigam.

➤ **Education**

“Civil Services Day” was observed by the Education department at Daman on 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015.

➤ **CDPO**

State Level Programme of “**Beti Bachao- Beti Padhao**” Abhiyan was organised at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium, Daman on 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2015. The Hon’ble Administrator and Hon’ble Member of Parliament has motivated the community about the importance of appropriate sex ratio in the community.

➤ **Fire**

- Fire Safety Week was observed by Department of Fire from 14<sup>th</sup> April to 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015. 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 was also observed as a “FIRE SERVICE COMMEMORATION DAY PARADE” to pay homage to those brave fire personnel who lost their lives in performance of their duties.
- Fire safety training have been given to Industrial employees, ITI, TTI, Polytechnic students, instructor, JawaharNavodayaVidhyalaya and Anganwadi Workers during observance of Fire Service Week from 14<sup>th</sup> April to 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015.

**D. Other Important Activity (in brief):**

- Jan Sunvai Programme has been organised in Marwad Group Gram Panchayat on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2015. The issues related with Health, Education, Electricity, Infrastructural Development, Water Supply etc. were raised by the villagers and the officer concerned assured the villagers to solve the issues related with their department.
- The ASI team, Baroda region has visited Daman on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 and agreed to preserve historical monuments and forts in UT of Daman & Diu. The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Hon’ble Administrator, UT of Daman & Diu.
- 2 day passport service camp was organised at Diu on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 in which large number of Local public solved their passport related issues.
- Health checkup camp was organised in the village Dunetha of Varkund Group Gram Panchayat on 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2015. The Medical Officers and specialists provided their clinical services in the health camp.
- Daman District Legal Aid Authority and Diu District Legal Aid Authority have organised LokAdalats in both the districts on 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2015.
- 2 day LEP training was organised at Diu under SSA for teacher of standard II. 18 teachers and 18 Head Masters were trained in the training programme.
