

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of February 2015)**

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of February, 2015 is highlighted below.

**A. VIP Visit :**

- The Hon'ble State Minister of Home Affairs, Shri Haribhai Chaudhary visited UTs of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli from 15th to 17th February, 2015 to review the status of various projects in the UTs.
- The Hon'ble Minister was given the Guard of Honour by the UT Administration on his arrival.
- The Hon'ble Minister has inaugurated Patalia Bridge at Daman on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 in presence of the Hon'ble Administrator and Member of Parliament and other dignitaries.

- The Hon'ble Minister held a meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 with Senior Officers of the Administration. A brief presentation covering the activities of the Administration was given by the Administrator and important issues requiring the attention of MHA were flagged.

- The Hon'ble Minister has also interacted with leaders of various political parties in the Conference Hall, Secretariat, Moti Daman on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.

## **B. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

### **(i) Major Works completed during the month of February, 2015:**

- Construction of RMC First floor at existing ground floor building of Health Department at Fudam, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 19.00 lakh.
- Gunniting works to the overhead at Vanakbara, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 10.00 lakh.

## **C. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of February, 2015:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of January, 2015 is as follows:

### **➤ Agriculture**

- Sprayer Pumps has been distributed to the 17 Nos. of SC/ST/ Small & Marginalized (SM) farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Storage bin set has been distributed to the 26 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Pesticide has been distributed to the 16 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Bio pesticide/bio fertilizer has been distributed to the 14 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (**10 beneficiaries**) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher, winnowing fan, submersible water pump (**09 beneficiary**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to **04 farmers** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Education**

Provided nutritious food to about **14,184 students** (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 85.45 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST boy** students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 91.78 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST girl** students.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released of Rs.80,000/-to 16 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC Jeevan Kishor (one time deposit) policy of Rs. 41,800/- has been made in the name of 20 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **6858** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1629** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1305** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **224** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **6,222** **Old Age** pensioners, **Widows** pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

**D. Organisation of important Events during the month of February, 2015:**

➤ **Sports**

- Daman District **Inter School Tournament 2014-15** was organised for Tennis Ball Cricket for the age group of 14, 17 and 19 (Boys and Girls) at Daman from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.
- The students of age group 14, 17 and 19 years (Boys & Girls) had participated in 60<sup>th</sup> National School Games 2014-15 at Rajkot from 17<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- 16 Children of Bal Bhavan, Daman had participated in “**India Got Talent**” show organize by National Color TV Channel on 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.
- A team of 10 Children along with 1 coach had participated in “**International Karate Championship**” at Mumbai from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2015 and awarded with 2 Gold Medals & 4 Bronze Medals.
- **Workshop on Garba** (under 12 years girls) has been organised from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2015 by Bal Bhavan, Diu. 20 girls had participated in the programme.
- “**Jammu and Kashmir Festival**” and “**AranyaParv**” (a cultural exchange programme) was organised at Diu from 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015 in collaboration with West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur.

➤ **Education**

- 5 Days Master Trainer Training Programme has been organised at SarvajanikVidyalaya, Daman from 28/02/2015 to 04/03/2015. 14-14 teachers of UT of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli were trained as master trainer.
- A seminar on “Medieval Western Indian Literature” was organised at Diu College during last week of February, 2015.

➤ **Fire**

Fire safety training has been given to students of 3 Anganwadi Kendras, student and teaching staff of 7 schools and Panchayat members and villagers of Pariari Gramm Panchayat at Daman.

➤ **CDPO**

- NukkadNatak/Street Play were organised on “**BetiBachao - BetiPadhao**” at various Anganwadi Centres from 11<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015 in coordination with Song and Drama Division, Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, Govt. of India.
- The message of “**BetiBachao- BetiPadhao**” was also given to the community through Mobile van.

- Mahila meeting has been carried out in various villages of Daman district in which MukhyaSevikas of Anganwadi Centres had sensitize the women groups on cleanliness and healthy environment.
- 2 MukhyaSevika of Anganwadi Centres of Daman & Diu were trained on Indira Gandhi MatritvaSahyog Yojana and SABLA at Indore.

➤ **Health**

- Second round of Pulse Polio Programme was organised on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015 in which **26,849** eligible children were administrated Polio drops.
- HIV/AIDS training programme for students and teachers was organised from 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 at Daman. The participants were sensitize on mode of HIV infection and its prevention and control along with adolescent growing process behaviors and psychology.
- Training Programme for management of Swine Flu patient was organised at Diu on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2015. The Health care providers were sensitize on universal safety precaution vice dealing with Swine Flu patients and prevention and control of the dieses in the Community.
