

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of January 2015)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of January, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of January, 2015:

- Construction of **Additional class rooms** at Govt. High School, Bhimpore, Daman has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 161.93 lakh**.
- Construction of **Additional Toilet blocks** in various Govt. High School / Higher Secondary School at Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 47.00 lakh**.
- Construction of administrative Block on first floor of existing of Conference Hall at C.H.C., Ghoghla, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 43.00 lakh.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of January, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of January, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to **04 farmers** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

- Provided 62 grown and vaccinated poultry Bird at nominal cash rate of Rs. 100/- kg base to **07 beneficiaries** under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about **14,389 students** (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 50.13lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST boy** students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 51.13 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST girl** students.

➤ **Health**

Financial assistance released of **Rs.2.10 lakh** to **42 Mothers** under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **7132 Children** (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1628 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers**.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1320 Adolescent Girls – School Going**.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **230 Adolescent Girls – Out of School**.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **6,131 old age pensioners, Widows pensioners and Disabled pensioners** under National Social Assistance Programme.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of January, 2015:

➤ **Sports**

- Daman District **Inter School Tournament 2014-15** was held at Daman from 10th to 30th January, 2015 at Football Ground, Daman. Various sports events like **Tug of War, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi** were organized for the age group of 17 to 19 years (boys and girls).
- **60th National School Games 2014-15** was organised for Tennis Ball Cricket from 21st to 24th January, 2015 at Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- Children of Bal Bhavan, Daman had participated in “**PRAGATI 2015**” on 10th January, 2015. Mr. Mihir of Bal Bhavan, Daman has got second prize in “Best of Waste” competition.
- **Patriotic Dance and folk dance** was organised at Football Ground, Moti Daman during **Republic Day parade** on 26th January, 2015.
- “**Tarang – 2015**”, a Cultural Exchange Programme with Vishakhapatnam and Shimoga was organised at Bal Bhavan, Diu on 26th & 27th January, 2015. **120 artists** participated in the **Cultural Exchange Programme** in collaboration with West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur.

➤ **Education**

- RMSA allocation of **Rs. 90,000/-** to each school has been transferred to **12 Govt. Higher Secondary Schools** of Daman for **Remedial Teaching to weaker students of Std. IX**.
- 350 students of Daman district visited Kutch area of Gujarat State under study tour organised under RMSA.
- Training was organised by “Maa Foundation” at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium in which Principals, Head Masters and Teachers of all Govt. Secondary Schools of Daman were sensitized on career counseling to the students.
- The poster competition was organised on 22nd January, 2015 on the theme “**Jagrut Matdata- Loktantrika Aadhaar**” by the Education Department.

➤ **Police**

- Daman Police had conducted a special drive from 1st January to 31st January, 2015 to trace out the missing/abandoned children under “**OPERATION SMILE**”. **3 missing children** have been recovered during the drive.
- **Jan Sunvayi** was organized on 10th January, 2015 for village Kachigam and Zari under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner. The queries of villagers of various Govt. departments were addressed.
- **Road safety** week has been celebrated from 11th to 17th January, 2015. **Interschool painting competition, nukkadnatak and dance competition**, walkathon, cycle rally, driver training, Health checkups of drivers has been carried out with co-ordination of concerned Govt. Departments.

➤ **CDPO**

National Girl Child Day was celebrated on 24th January, 2015 in all Anganwadi Centres. Group discussion meeting has been conducted in the villages to sensitize the community about **ill effects of sex determination and sex selective abortion**. The issues related with **Domestic Violence, disadvantages of Early Marriages, Dowry, importance of child immunization, importance of birth and death registration** etc. were discussed.

➤ **Health**

First round of Pulse Polio Programme was organised on 18th January, 2015 in which **26,916 eligible children** were administered Polio drops.

➤ **Tourism**

D. Recruitment (Appointment / Promotion) made during the month.

The post of Medical Officer, Sr. Filaria Inspector, Pharmacist, Lab Technician and ANM (3 Nos.) have been filled up in Health Department.

E. Other Important Activity (in brief):

- **New Industrial policy has been launched** on 22nd January, 2015 under objective "**Make in India**" campaign single window system. This will create about **40,000 jobs** and facilitate above Rs. 5,000 Crore new investment in next 5 years. The thrust areas are Textile, Information Technology, Pharmaceuticals, Light engineering, Plastics, Marble tile, Tourism creation & Entertainment

industries. The objective of new Industrial policy are Skill Development, Ease of doing business, Investor friendly environment, Development of Tourism Infrastructure, Investor facilitation portal and Incentive to labour intensive & green industries.

- Rally on “**BetiBachao-BetiPadhao**” abhiyan was inaugurated by the Hon’ble Administrator. The Aanganwadi workers have created mass awareness in the community about BetiBachao-BetiPadhao. All the schools has also organised awareness rally on the issue in their respective surrounding area.
- The UT Administration has celebrated **National Voters Day** on 25th January, 2015. The Hon’ble Administrator has awarded best Booth Level Officers (BLOs) and other Govt. officials for their efforts during enrolment campaign along with Hon’ble Member of Parliament and Sr. Officers of the UT Administration. Similar activities were organised in Diu district.
- **Kite Festival, 2015** was organised at Jampore beach, Daman on 17th January, 2015. The Hon’ble Administrator has inaugurated the function along with Hon’ble Member of Parliament and other local public representative. Large number of tourist had enjoyed in the kite Mahotsav.
- **RajbhashaKriyanvayanSamiti meeting** was held on 15th January, 2015 at Conference Hall, Secretariat, Daman. The Development Commissioner awarded the best performing departments and employees on the occasion.
