

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of March 2015)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of March, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) New Major Works started during the month of March, 2015:

- Foundation Stone for Construction of Under Ground Sewerage System & Water Treatment Plant, Diu was laid down on 7th March, 2015 and the work will be completed upto September, 2016 at a cost of **Rs. 43.00 Crore.**
- Foundation Stone for beautification of “Sunset Point”, Diu was laid down on 7th March, 2015 and the work will be completed upto September, 2016 at a cost of **Rs. 7.57 Crore.**
- Foundation Stone for Construction of Indoor Sports Stadium and other facility, Diu was laid down on 7th March, 2015 and the work will be completed upto September, 2016 at a cost of **Rs. 7.21 Crore.**
- Foundation Stone for Construction of “Viewing deck on heritage wall”, Diu was laid down on 7th March, 2015 and the work will be completed upto September, 2015 at a cost of **Rs. 3.47 Crore.**
- The beautification of Jogging Track at Goghala, Diu has been initiated and will be completed upto September, 2015 at a cost of **Rs. 3.42 Crore.**

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of March, 2015:

- 220 KV Transmission line between 400/200 KV Magarwada (PGCIL) to 220/66 KV Magarwada, Daman has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 8.61 Crore.**

- Improvement, widening, raising & re-surfacing including construction of RCC storm water drain on MDR starting from MashalChowk to Patalia via Bhimpore Char Rasta at Nani Daman at a cost of **Rs. 5.61 Crore.**
- Improvement, widening & re-surfacing of road starting from Kadaiya school upto Moti Vankad via BhimporeChar Rasta upto Coastal Highway with construction of road Divider RCC Box storm water drain at a cost of **Rs. 5.14 Crore.**
- Improved metering system, communication, MRT Facilities & special tools and plant/workshop in Daman & Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 2.94Crore.**
- The Hon'ble Administrator, UT of Daman & Diu has inaugurated Pile Jetty for landing of Passenger Vessels at Diu on 7th March, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 1.21Crore.**
- Providing, Supplying & Laying 250 mm dia pipeline from Kalai River at Bamanpuja to raw water reservoir at BhimTalav, Magarwada, Moti Daman at a cost of **Rs. 0.66 Crore.**
- Construction of New Conference Hall at Collectorate, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.53 Crore** and dedicated to the public on 20th March, 2015.
- Construction of 'E' type Bungalow near Treatment Plant at Ghoghla, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.40 Crore.**
- Gunniting work to overhead tank at Koliwad, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.10 Crore.**

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of March, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of March, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to **01 farmer** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

Subsidy provided to 2 women beneficiaries (Rs. 2.34 lakh) under the Integrated Dairy Development Project.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about 14,292 students (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.
- Stipend of Rs. 2.28 lakh (Rs. 1000/ per month per trainee) has been paid to 76 numbers of trainees under TSP for 3 month training from 1/12/2014 to 28/02/2015.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released of Rs.10,000/-to 2 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC Jeevan Kishor (one time deposit) policy of Rs. 41,800/- has been made in the name of 12 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **7194** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1626** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1320** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **259** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of March, 2015:

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- 1stBal Bhavan National Level Karate Championship has been organised by Bal Bhavan, Daman. 280 Students had participated in the camp from all over India.
- **Workshop on painting** has been organised from 9th to 14th March, 2015 by Bal Bhavan, Diu. 36 students had participated in the workshop.
- **Workshop on Gujarati folk dance** has been organised from 2nd to 7thMarch, 2015 by Bal Bhavan, Diu. 56 students had participated in the programme.

- **Workshop on Paper Machine & Pot decoration** has been organised from 2nd to 12th March, 2015 by Bal Bhavan, Diu. 42 students had participated in the programme.

➤ **Education**

- **Environment Building Programme** was organized on 27th March, 2015 at Education Hall, Nani Daman for **Disable students** under RMSA.
- Four disabled girls students were awarded Rs. 2,000/- for purchase of aid and appliances under IEDSS Scheme of RMSA.

➤ **CDPO**

The Orientation Training Camps in two batches for Anganwadi workers has been organised from 10th to 11th March, 2015 and 26th to 27th March, 2015 at ICDS Office, Daman.

➤ **Agriculture**

Two days training programme on **Green House Technology** for Flower Production, Soil & Water Conservation was organised in which 46 farmers were trained.

D. Other Important Activity (in brief):

- Foundation Stone for **Construction of Toilet Blocks** in Pariari Village under **Sansad Aadarsh Gram Yojana** has been laid down by Hon'ble Member of Parliament in presence of Development Commissioner and other dignitaries on 21st March, 2015.
- **“Diu Darshan” Sarthi Bus Seva** has been started in Diu from 1st March, 2015. The Bus facility is providing cost effective transport services to the tourist at Diu.
- The **International Women’s Day** was celebrated by various departments of UT Administration of Daman & Diu on 8th March, 2015. **Seminars, group discussion meeting, rally** etc. were organised for empowering the women.
- A team of Senior Officers under the leadership of the Development Commissioner had participated in tourism trade show at **Berlin, Germany** from 4th to 8th March, 2015. The team had presented Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli as new tourism destination on world map.
- The Administrator Advisory Council meeting was held on 12th March, 2015 at Conference Hall, Secretariat, Moti Daman. The issues related with Minority

Communities were discussed and appropriate directions were issued to concerned authorities for appropriate action on minorities related issues.

- **Cleanliness Campaign** was organised in Pariari Village on 15th March, 2015, under **Sansad Aadarsh Gram Yojana**. The Hon'ble Member of Parliament had participated in the campaign along with other public representative and villagers.
- The UT Administration of Daman & Diu has participated in "Make in India- Development Procurement and Social Programme" seminar under the leadership of Hon'ble Administrator at Mumbai. The seminar was organised by western region CII.
- **National Tourism Council** meeting with UT Administration of Daman & Diu was held at Diu on 28th March, 2015. During the meeting, it was discussed and decided that, CII will make efforts for development of tourism infrastructure in Diu under PPP mode.
- Under "**Beti Bachao – Beti Padhao**" **Abhiyan** a meeting was held on 30th March, 2015 at Daman in which Public representatives of Urban and Rural local bodies were sensitized on issue. The Public representatives were requested to sensitize the community on "Beti Bachao- Beti Padhao" in their respective areas.
