

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of August 2015)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of August, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) New Major Works started during the month of August, 2015:

- Foundation Stone for Construction of **New Pedestrian Bridge at Damanganga River**, Daman at a cost of Rs. 19.45 Crore was laid by **Hon'ble Administrator**, on 18th August, 2015.
- Foundation Stone for Construction of **New Kachigam Magarwada Bridge at Damanganga River**, Daman at a cost of Rs. 47 Crore was laid by **Hon'ble Administrator**, on 18th August, 2015.
- Foundation stone for construction of Multi Office Complex for P.W.D. opposite Police Out Post, Moti Daman has been laid down by the Chief Engineer on 27th August, 2015 and the work will be completed at the cost of Rs. 7 crore.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of August, 2015:

- **The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated Modern School Building** at Daman on 18th August, 2015 which was completed at a cost of **Rs. 4.50 Crore**.
- Establishment of 1MWP on grid Solar Plant at Magarwada, Daman at a cost of Rs. 34,000,000/-

- Construction of composite RCC structure of 1,50,000 Litre capacity overhead tank & 3,00,000 Litre capacity sump at Parkota Sheri, Nani Daman at a cost of Rs. 67,10,217/-
- Construction of composite RCC structure of 1,50,000 litre capacity overhead tank & 3,00,000 litre Capacity sump at Kothapat Sheri, Nani Daman at a cost of Rs. 65,51,552/-
- Construction of store room for Government Seed Multiplication farm at Kachigam, Nani Daman at a cost of Rs. 16,11,357/-
- Diversion of existing 66KV D/C Una – Diu Transmission line to nearby area at Dangerwadi village in Diu at a cost of Rs. 16,90,000/-
- Construction of fishermen Shed towards VadisheriPilani Jetty at Vanakbara, Diu at a cost of Rs. 34,00,000/-
- Construction of New School building of Government High School, Saudwadi, Diu under RAMSA scheme at a cost of Rs. 57,48,000/-
- Strengthening of existing earthen bund from Diu Bridge approach to Gandhipara, Diu at a cost of Rs. 49,00,000/-

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of August, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of August, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **Fisheries**

- An amount of Rs.26, 40,000/- has been disbursed to 22 Boat owners of Diu district for replacement of Kerosene driven OBM Engine by LPG OBM Engine.
- An amount of Rs. 73, 04,185/- has been disbursed to 99 Boat owners of Diu District for purchase of VHF, GPS and other communication equipment.

- An amount of Rs. 9,16,600/- has been disbursed to family members of 50 fishermen captured by Pakistan Marine Security Agency (PMSA) for the period from 1st January, 2015 to 31st May, 2015.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **6199** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1554** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1323** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **203** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 6.91lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST boy** students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 11.25 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST girl** students.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **11,030 Old Age** pensioners, **Widows** pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of August, 2015:

- The U.T. Level Independence day function was organized at Jetty, Moti Daman in presence of freedom fighters, Leaders of local bodies, public & Government Officers.
- The International Youth Day was celebrated on 12th August, 2015 at Government College, Daman by Secretary (health) & Director, Medical & Health Services, Daman. The Youths were sensitized on AIDS & HIV.
- The RajbhasaVibhag, U.T. of Daman & Diu, has organized 'Hindi Pakhvada' from 27th August, 2015.
- The State Level NariyalPoornima Festival was celebrated at Jetty, Nani Daman on 29th August, 2015. The Bal Bhavan Board has organized various cultural events on the occasion.

- A training programme on Registration of Birth & Death, Act 1969 and application of CRS software was organized under the chairmanship of Development Commissioner on 28th August, 2015 at Conference Hall, Collectorate, Daman. The Deputy Registrar General Shri R. K. Gautam & Assistant Director Shri Sandeep Rai has facilitated the programme along with Joint Director of CRS officer, Gandhinagar. The participants from Diu had also joined the programme through Video Conferencing under the Chairmanship of Collector, Diu.
- The Gram Panchayat Election at Daman and Gram Panchayat & District Panchayat Election was announced on 29th August, 2015 by the Director, Panchayat Election, U.T. of Daman & Diu.
- **Education**
 - The Directorate of Education of Daman & Diu District has organized **Science exhibition** from 19th August, 2015 to 20th August, 2015 to promote the scientific activities among students through various working & non-working models in the exhibition.
 - A meeting of local public representatives has been organized on 18th August, 2015 at Conference Hall, Secretariat, Moti Daman to discuss new education policy.
- **Health**
 - Second round of seasonal of insecticide spraying operation has been started from 15th August and will continue till 15th September, 2015. Total 2447 houses and 2129 rooms have been sprayed so far.
- **Bal Bhavan**
 - 20 children of Bal Bhavan Board, Diu participated in ‘Woolen Art Workshop’ from 3rd August, 2015 to 7th August, 2015.
 - ‘Rakhi Making Workshop’ was organized from 24th August, 2015 to 27th August, 2015 at Bal Bhavan Board, Diu. Total 24 Students had participated in the workshop.
- **Electricity**
 - The Department has initiated services like e-Billing, e-Collection, e-Tendering, e-Indent, On-line Complain Management System.

➤ **Sports**

- UT level Subroto Mukherjee Cup Football Tournament – 2015 was organized from 4th August, 2015 to 5th August, 2015 for Sub- junior Boys (U- 14) and Junior Boys (U-17). Total 16 teams had participated in the tournament.
- Daman District Inter School Football Tournament – 2015 was organized from 31st August 2015 to 7th September, 2015. Total 9 teams participated in the tournament.
