

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of October 2015)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of October, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) New Major Works started during the month of October, 2015:

- Foundation stone for **construction of sewerage plant at Moti Daman** was laid down by the Hon'ble Administrator on 19th October, 2015 and the same will be completed at the cost of **Rs. 19 Crore**.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of October, 2015:

- **Construction of parallel bridge to existing Diu-Ghoghla Bridge** at Diu District was completed at a cost of **Rs. 38 Crore**.
- **Renovation of Ground Floor and horizontal construction of First Floor** at Magarwada Sub- Station, Moti Daman was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.96 Crore**.
- **Construction of Library Hall** above existing shed for Government Polytechnic at Technical Training Institute, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.58 Crore**.
- **Addition and alteration to the existing incinerator room** including **construction of a Hall** on first floor at CHC, Ghoghla, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.42 Crore**.
- **Strengthening and Renovation of existing fishing pile jetty** with guniting work at seashore, Ghoghla – Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.40 Crore**.

- **Construction of Laboratory building** for Government Polytechnic at Technical Training Institute, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.32 Crore** on.
- **Construction of second floor for emergency operation Centre** at Collectorate, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.27 Crore**.
- **Providing and fixing road furniture on MDR** from Nagoa Circle to Vanakbara at Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.23 Crore**.
- **Illumination at Sea Shore wall** from Smarak (opp. Collectorate) till Government Circuit House- II, Fort Road, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.22 Crore**.
- **Providing installation Testing and Commissioning of stretcher lift** for exterior of Government Hospital at Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.22 Crore**.
- **Construction of Compound wall** at Government Higher Secondary School (girls) at Ghoghla, Diu was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.18 Crore**.
- **Supplying, Fixing, testing & Commissioning of display** (full HD LED) Light Board in Diu district was completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.10 crore**.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of October, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of October, 2015 is as follows:

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **6239** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1613** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1358** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **169** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 20.49lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST boy** students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 24.03 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST girl** students.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **10838 Old Age** pensioners, **Widow** Pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Technical Training Institute**

- Stipend of Rs. 82,000/- has been disbursed to 82 SC/ST trainees under TSP scheme.

➤ **Fisheries**

- An amount of Rs. 73, 04,185/- has been disbursed to 99 Boat owners of Diu District for purchase of VHF, GPS and other communication equipment.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released for a total of **Rs. 2.50 lakh** to 50 Mothers under **MatruSamrudhiYojana (MSY)** scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs. 41,966/- has been made in the name of 21 girl child under **Dikri Development Scheme (DDS)**.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Tractors facility has been provided to **24 farmers** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

- The Collector Daman & Diu has organized coordination meeting on 31st October, 2015 with Sarpanchas for speeding up the process of Aadhar enrollment in the rural areas.

- The Directorate of Medical & Health Services, U. T. of Daman & Diu has launched "**Yellow Fever Vaccination**" are available on 1st& 3rd Tuesday of every month at Primary Health Centres.

- The Health Department has launched food safety campaign in view of Diwali Festival, most of the food establishments were inspected & food samples were taken for testing.

➤ **Education**
