

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of January 2016)**

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of January, 2016 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) Major Works completed during the month of January, 2016:**

- Construction of Cement concrete pavement over newly constructed dry dock platform at Jalaram Society area, Vanakbara, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs 1.71 Crore.
- Construction of Cement concrete pavement over newly constructed Fishing platform at Pavli Village, Bucharwada, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs. 1.04 Crore.

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of January, 2016:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of January, 2016 is as follows:

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **10961** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1565** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1445** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **161** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of **Rs. 37.98lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST boy** students.
- Cash incentive of **Rs. 35.99 lakh** released to parents of **SC/ST girl** students.
- Financial Assistance for Self Employment on service oriented units was released to 30 beneficiaries under Tribal Sub Plan and amount of **Rs. 0.78 Lakh** were disbursed to the youths.
- Top-Up Scholarship amount of **Rs. 314.23 Lakh** was released.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **8625 Old Age** pensioners, **Widow Pensioners** and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released for a total of **Rs. 2.45 lakh** to 49 Mothers under **MatruSamrudhiYojana (MSY)** scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs. 42,017/- has been made in the name of 21 girl child under **Dikri Development Scheme (DDS)**.

➤ **Fisheries**

- Financial Assistance of Rs. 2,81,400/- was released to family members of 23 Fishermen captured by Pakistan Marine Agency (PMSA) for the period of 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2015.

- Financial Assistance of Rs. 20.57 Lakh was released to 41 Nos. of Beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme for purchase of Fisheries Requisites / Equipment etc.

➤ **AHVS**

- Financial assistance released for a total of **Rs. 4.80 lakh** to 16 beneficiaries under “**Small Scale Poultry Unit (layer)**” scheme @ Rs. 30,000/- to each beneficiary.

**C. Organization of important Events during the month of January, 2016:**

- The National School of Drama has organized AdhirangMahotsava at Daman from 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 to 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. About 700 artists of various parts of the country had performed their local folk. The issues related with tribal were also discussed by the expert speakers during the Mahotsava.
- The Central Deputy Election Commissioner visited Daman on 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 & reviewed the Electoral Revision work with concerned officers.
- The Election Department of Daman has organized cycle rally on the occasion of National Voter's Day. The main function of National Voter's Day was organized at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2016
- The Police Department has organized Self-Defense Camp for Girls in Shri Machhi Mahajan School on 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2016.
- The Development Commissioner has inaugurated the Online File Tracking System in the Conference Hall, Secretariat, Daman on 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2016.
- Daman Police has organized health Checkup Camps for Government Drivers on the occasion of 27<sup>th</sup> Road Safety Week.

- Pulse Polio Immunization programme was organized on 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 in which 20,904 eligible children were administered polio dosage.
- Walk-a-thon was organized by the Police Department on 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. The Students of various schools sensitized the community about safety measures on road through the walk-a-thon.

- Health Department, Daman had organized training for link workers on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2016. They were trained for carrying out emergency preventive roll during accident & trauma situation.
- Health Department, Daman conducted an Advocacy workshop for Principals/ Headmasters and Nodal teachers from Government Aided / Private, Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools of Daman District on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. A total of 40 participated in this workshop.
- Health Department, Daman conducted RBSK Orientation and DD National Women's Day WIFS & MHs on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 for Primary & Upper Primary and on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 for Secondary School Teachers.
- Health Department, Daman organized Polio Immunization Training on 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2016.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**
