

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of April, 2016)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of April, 2016 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of April, 2016:

- Repairing and renovation of existing fisheries pile jetty and platform situated opp. Fish auction market, Vanakbara, Diu was completed at the cost of Rs. 53 Lakh on 7th April, 2016.
- Painting of Aerodrome compound wall at Airport, Diu was completed at the cost of Rs. 51 lakh on 15th April, 2016.
- Providing and fixing road side barrier at various places on the four lane road from Diu to Vanakbarawas completed at the cost of Rs. 43.45 Lakh on 17th April, 2016.
- Providing and fixing of partition wall and furnishing of RTO office at Collectorate, Diu was completed at the cost of Rs. 10.50 Lakh on 25th April, 2016.
- Renovation & Painting work at RTO Complex, Nani Daman was completed at the cost of Rs. 13 lakh on 25th April, 2016
- Repairs and Replacement of roof of food grains godown near RTO complex was completed at the cost of Rs. 9 lakh on 20th April, 2016.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of April, 2016:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of April, 2016 is as follows:

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **5933** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1474** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1339** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **119** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **11,240** **Old Age** pensioners, **Widow** Pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

- Provided 300 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg base to 16 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

C. Organization of important Events during the month of April, 2016:

- Civil Services Day was observed in U.T. on 21st April, 2016. The best performing employees were awarded on the occasion at Secretariat, Moti Daman.
- The District Panchayat, Daman has distributed Ice Boxes to 72 Fisher-women on 28th April, 2016.

- Basic Fire Safety Training to the General Public was given at bus Stop, Nani Daman on 15th April, 2016; Supreme Residency, Nani Daman & Mid-Day Meal Ladies on 16th April, 2016; Damini Woman's Foundation, Nani Daman on 18th April, 2016; Bal wadi ladies & Magarwada Panchayat, Moti Daman on 19th April, 2016; Adarsh Nagar Society, Dunetha, Nani Daman on 20th April, 2016; Shive Complex Dunetha, Nani Daman on 23rd April, 2016 by the Fire Department.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- **“Paper Craft Workshop”** was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Diu from 4th April, 2016 to 8th April, 2016. Total of 28 students participated in this workshop.
- **“Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti”** was celebrated by the students of Bal Bhavan Board, Diu, Bal Bhavan Kendra, Ghoghla and Bal Bhavan Board, Vanakbara by performing various cultural programmes on 14th April, 2016. Total of 46 students participated in this programme.
- **“3rd National Karate Championship”** organized by “Complete Karate – Do Academy at Karnataka” in which 4 Students from Bal Bhavan Board, Daman had participated and won 2 Gold, 2 Silver and 2 bronze medals.

➤ **Sports**

- **Special Coaching Camp** for Chess was organized at Badminton Hall, Bal Bhavan Building, Moti Daman from 26th April to 2nd May, 2016 for the players of Daman District.

- **UT Level Badminton and Table Tennis selection tournament -2015-16** was organized from 25th April, 2016 to 30th April, 2016 at Badminton Hall & Table Tennis court, Fort Area, Moti Daman. The selected students will participate in 61st National School Games Badminton (U-17 Boys & Girls) scheduled to be held at NTR Stadium, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh from 3rd to 7th May, 2016 and Table Tennis (U-14 Boys & Girls) tournament scheduled to be held at AmbedkarBhavan, Machilipatnam, near Vijaywada Railway Junction, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh from 26th April, 2016 to 2nd May, 2016.
- **125th Birth anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar** was celebrated from 14th April to 24th April – 2016 in all Gram Panchayats of this UT under the campaign “**Gram Uday se Bharat UdayTak**”. Felicitations of children in various fields, Prabhatpheri, cleanliness drive, awareness workshop for farmers about scheme related to agriculture and Animal Husbandry, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Volleyball tournament, honoring of Senior Citizens, telecast of Prime Minister’s address, legal literacy camps and special gram sabhas were organized in this UT.
- An action plan under “**Swachh Bharat Mission**” has been prepared by the Tourism Department with objective to ensure total cleanliness in the most visited tourist places.
