

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of June, 2016)

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of June, 2016 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major works started during the month of June, 2016:

- 10 Developmental works have been started by the District Panchayat Diu and will be completed at a cost of Rs. 2.06 Crore.
- Construction of RCC road with Hume pipe gutter at FakirjivaSheri, Nani Daman will be completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.21 Crore**
- The repairing and renovation of Municipal Library at Moti Daman will be completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.13 Crore.**
- The Cleaning of Rain water gutter in Municipal area of Nani Daman & Moti Daman for the year 2016-17 will be completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.49 Crore.**
- The construction and providing of protection wall at Ambawadi, Moti Daman and will be completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.21 Crore.**

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of June, 2016:

- The work for shifting of Control room of 66/11 KV sub- station at Malala, Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 3.28 Crore.**
- The preparation, gradation and development of runway strip of Aerodrome at Airport; Diu has been completed at a cost of **Rs. 1.45 Crore.**

- 3 Developmental projects related with providing RO water purification System, electrification, re-carpeting of CC road with drainage line and construction of retraining wall have been completed by the District Panchayat, Diu at a cost of **Rs. 0.56 Crore.**
- Constructions of Sub-center with ANM quarters at Dori-Kadaiya, Daman have been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.42 Crore.**
- The illuminations of new road near check post at Ghoghla, Diu have been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.36 Crore.**
- The construction of volleyball and Basketball ground and furnishing of child protection unit at Diu have been completed at a cost of **Rs. 0.24 Crore.**

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of June, 2016:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of June, 2016 is as follows:

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **5910** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1568** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1339** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **119** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Education**

- Laptops under “**UDAAN**” scheme have been distributed to **1874 students** of class 11 and 1st year students of government Polytechnic.
- **Free text books** have been distributed to all students (Govt. & Govt. aided) of Class I to VII in UT of Daman & Diu.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Top Up Scholarship of **Rs. 133.64 Lakh** have released to **1194** student beneficiaries.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pensions have been released to **8817 Old Age, Widow** and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Health**

- Anti-Malaria month campaign was inaugurated on 1st June, 2016. During the Anti-Malaria month (1st to 30th June, 2016) the communities have been sensitized by “Workshop cum sensitization Programme”, “Malaria Awareness Rath”, street dramas and displaying hoardings & banners, etc. community was also sensitized on cleanliness and removal of water logging on their surrounding areas for prevention & control of vector borne diseases.
- To improve the sex ratio and lowering down the maternity mortality, an amount of **Rs. 8.00 lakh** to **50** beneficiaries has been disbursed under “**Dikri Development Scheme**” & “**Matru Samriddhi Yojana**” in UT of Daman & Diu.

➤ **Fisheries**

- Provided safety and communication equipment to **17** boat owners at the cost of **Rs.3.19 lakhs**.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Certified and hybrid seeds, agriculture machinery, spray pumps, storage bin set, tools / Implements have been provided to **449** ST & SC / marginal farmers on **50% subsidy** at Daman. Paddy seeds (Mini-kit) has also been provided to **200** SC & ST / small marginal farmers on **100% subsidy**.
- Tractors facilities have been provided to **8 farmers** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

- Two day training programme was organized by the Agriculture Department on 15th& 16th June, 2016 on“**Organic Farming**” in SansadAadarsh Gram, Pariyari, Moti Daman through Regional Centre of Organic Farming, Govt. of India, Nagpur.

C. Economic Development in the month of June, 2016:

- The new investment proposal of **Rs. 30.16 Crore** with and employability of **316 persons** has been received under single window system of Department of Industries, Daman
- The final result of 6th Economic Census has been published.

D. Organization of important Events during the month of June, 2016:

- Joint Statement has been signed between Secretary (Power), UT of Daman & Diu and Joint Secretary, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India to ensure 24x7 power supply under “**Power for all (PFA)**”programme on 16th June, 2016 at Goa.
- “**International Yoga Day**” was celebrated in the UT with success. In addition to UT level function, large number of schools and NGO groups had also organized yoga programme on the occasion in rural, as well as urban areas of UT of Daman & Diu.
- Cleanliness drive in forest areas were under taken from 1st to 15th June, 2016 under “**Swachh Bharat Abhiyan**”. Large numbers of NGOs and Public Representatives haveparticipated in the programme.

➤ Education

- 2 day workshop was conducted for **208** cook cum helper on 9th& 10th June, 2016 under Mid-Day Meal Scheme. This training was conducted in coordination with PHC, Moti Daman & Nutrition experts.
- “**ShalaPraveshUtsav**” was conducted for students of Class I to 4 in Schools in coordination with Social Welfare Department. Educational Kits were distributed to the students of Class I.

- In-service teacher training programme was organized by RMSA from 6th to 10th June, 2016 and Education Department, Daman from 9th to 15th June, 2016. The expert facilitators trained the teachers on recent advanced techniques of learning & teaching in education.

➤ IT

- 2 new **SaralSeva Kendra (SSK)** (1 each at Daman & Diu) has been started. Various G2C and B2C services as well as services of the e-District and SSDG project are available through these kendras. A total of **12 SSK's** are now operational in UT of Daman & Diu.
- **3 new Aadhaar Centers with 3 Tablets** for child enrolment has been provided in UT of Daman & Diu.

➤ Fisheries

- Mop up round was held to provide Biometric ID cards to Fishermens.

➤ Tourism

- Department of Tourism, Daman & Diu has confirmed its participation in the 5th Travel East to be organized from 24th to 27th November, 2016 by **Confederation of Indian Industry** and “**Bharat Parv**” organized by the Ministry of Tourism to be organized from 12th to 17th August, 2016. Proposal has also been sent for participation in the **WTM- London, PATA Travel Mart and TTF**.
- The proposal for executing **Guide Training programmes** in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM) is also sent.
- The Department of Tourism has planned to promote tourism of Daman & Diu by advertising in Delhi Metro.

➤ Sports

- The Sports Department organized various sports activities on 21st June, 2016 at Jampore Beach, Moti Daman at Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY).

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- “**Miniature Painting Workshop**” was organized by the Bal Bhavan Board, Daman in collaboration with UZCC, Udaipur from 1st to 3rd June, 2016.
- “**Know your City, Daman**” was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Daman from 6th to 7th June, 2016. A professional form ITIHAAS, Delhi was invited to train the children for the same.
- “**Swagat – 2016**” was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Diu on 6th June, 2016. Total 56 students participated in this cultural programme.
- “**Knitting Workshop**” was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Diu from 14th to 17th June, 2016. Total 30 students participated in this workshop.
- “**International Children Painting Competition**” was organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Diu at Government High Secondary School, Diu on 30th June, 2016. Total 76 students of Diu district participated in this competition and selected painting were sent to Bulgaria for World Children Painting Competition.

➤ **Police**

- Daman Police had conducted a special drive in the month of January, 2016 to trace out **13** missing/abandoned children under “**OPERATION SMILE – II**”.
