

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of March 2016)**

The Union Territory is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of March, 2016 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) New Major Works started during the month of March, 2016:**

- Foundation stone for construction of 12 MLD water supply scheme at Magarwadand of 20.5 MLD at Dabhel, Nani Daman were laid by Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. These projects will be completed at a cost of Rs. 56.10 Crore.
- The foundation stone was laid by Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. of Daman & Diu for construction of Adivasi Cultural Centre at Moti Daman. The project will be completed at a cost of Rs. 4.68 Lakh. The work will be completed in next 9 months.

**(ii) Major Works completed during the month of March, 2016:**

- The Administrator, U.T. of Daman and Diu has inaugurated the Community Hall near Bus Stand, Ghoghla, Diu on 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2016.
- Construction of Fiber Shed for the open passage at Collectorate–Diu was completed at a cost of Rs 0.44 Crore on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2016.
- Construction of Fiber Roof shed at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs. 0.12 Crore on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2016.

- Renovation, Repairing and Replacement of old slab of 8 'A' type quarters for Police Department, Diu was completed at a cost of Rs. 0.40 Crore on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2016.
- Construction of Civil Engineering & Chemical Engineering building at Government Polytechnic, Daman was completed at a cost of Rs. 5.11 crore.
- Development of Cricket Ground at Government College, Nani Daman was completed at a cost of Rs. 5.11 Crore.

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of March, 2016:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of March, 2016 is as follows:

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to **6011** Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to **1583** pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **1375** Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to **152** Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to **4110** **Old Age** pensioners, **Widow** Pensioners and **Disabled** pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released for a total of **Rs. 3.50 lakh** to 70 Mothers under **MatruSamrudhiYojana (MSY)** scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs. 42,017/- has been made in the name of **63** girl child under **Dikri Development Scheme (DDS)**.
  
- **Animal Husbandry**
  - Provided 126 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg base to 9 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.
  
- **Fisheries**
  - Financial Assistance of Rs. 3.76 Lakh was released to family members of 13 Fishermen captured by Pakistan Marine Agency (PMSA).
  - An amount of Rs. 119.7 Lakh has been disbursed to 348 Boat owners of Diu District for purchase of VHF, GPS and other communication equipment.
  - Financial Assistance of Rs. 4.28 Lakh was released to 72 Nos. of Beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme for purchase of Fisheries Requisites / Equipment etc.
  
- **Technical Training Institute**
  - Stipend of Rs. 79,000/- has been disbursed to 79 SC/ST trainees under TSP scheme.
  
- **Crop Husbandry**
  - Tractors facility has been provided to **03farmer** on subsidy for Agriculture operations.
  
- **Agriculture**
  - Two days training programme on **Green House Technology** for Flower Production, Soil & Water Conservation was organised in which 37 farmers were trained.

- The **International Women's Day** was celebrated by various departments of UT Administration of Daman & Diu on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium. The **BetiJanmotsav** was also celebrated on this occasion.

- **“Lehar – The Wave” (A National Coastal Festival)** was organized by Bal Bhavan Board – Diu on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 in which various Coastal States performed their local dance.
- **“Mehendi& Paper Workshop”** has been organized by Bal Bhavan Board, Diu from 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2016 to 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. Total 30 students participated in this workshop.
- The Collector, Daman inaugurated **“2<sup>nd</sup> National Karate Championship - 2016”** organized by Bal Bhavan Board – Daman. Total 450 students participated in this competition.
