

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of December 2013)**

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of December, 2013 is highlighted below.

**A. New Initiatives**

➤ **SANJEEVANI SWASTHYA YOJNA**

The UT Administration formulated a Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme named “SanjeevaniSwasthyaBimaYojana” for all families which are below the poverty line and other poor families with an annual income below Rs. 1 lakh, the premium for which will be borne by the UT Administration. In addition, this scheme will be open for the pensioners and other families who can opt to join the scheme on paying the same premium, as well as over 1 lakh labour employed by the industry. A family up to five units will be enrolled under the health cover i.e. Head of household, spouse and up to three dependents. Medical care would be provided through reputed private hospitals in Mumbai, Surat, Rajkot and Ahmedabad empanelled under the scheme. The covered persons would be provided cashless service by the empanelled hospitals on the basis of a smart card issued to each covered family. The scheme provides an annual health cover of Rs 2 lakhs for each family as well as accidental death/disability cover of up to Rs 1 lakh.

The scheme was launched on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2013, the Liberation Day of U.T. of Daman and Diu and enrolment under the scheme started with effect from 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2013.

**B. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) New Major Works started during the month of December, 2013:**

- Foundation stone laid for construction of New Lekha Building for Accounts Department at Moti Daman.
- Foundation stone laid for construction of New Building (G.F + 6 storey) of Circuit House, Nani Daman.

**(ii) Major Works completed during the month of December, 2013:**

- Replacement of 600 mm dia existing gravity main water supply pipeline between Kalariajunction to Shah Apartment, at Varkund, Nani Daman.
- Replacement of existing 500 mm dia underground gravity main pipeline at Varkund, Nani Daman.

**C. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of December, 2013:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of December, 2013 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Free supply of bio pesticides and bio fertilizers (100% subsidy) to SC/ST/SM153 farmers.
- Supply of Paddy, Pulses, tools/Implements, Sprayer Pumps, Storage bin set and Agriculture machinery (50 % Subsidy) to 136 farmers.
- Tractors facility has been provided to 12 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

- Provided 1,106/- grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal cash rate of Rs.100/- kg baseto 110 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Fisheries**

- Provided safety and communication equipment to 290 boat owners at the cost of Rs.45.90 lakhs.

➤ **Education**

- Release of scholarship for 4 quarters to 41 NMMS beneficiaries(Rs.2,46,000/-)
- Provided nutritious food to about 14462 students (Std.I to VIII) under Mid Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Technical Education**

- Stipend of Rs.87,000/- paid to 87 SC/ST youth under TSP @ Rs.1000/- per month.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released of total Rs.0.30 lakh to 6 Mothers under MatruSuraksha Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiaries.
- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs.40,234/- has been made in the name of 74 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided nutritious food to 7572 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided Food grain to 1951 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided nutritious food to 1909 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided nutritious food to 392 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to 5063 old age pensioners, Widows pensioners and Disabled persons under National Social Assistance Programme.

**D. Organisation of important Events during the month of December, 2013:**

- Celebration of Liberation Day on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2013.
  - a) Inter school drawing/poster competition for age group 6 to 12 years, 12 to 18 years and 18 years and above was organized by BalBhavan on 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 in which 50 participants had made attractive paintings on the topic “Daman in the eyes of tourist”.
  - b) Inter school folk dance competition (Solo/Group) was organized on the occasion of Liberation Day on 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 at BalBhavan in which large number of participants had participated in the event.
  - c) The Hon’ble Administrator has inaugurated two days cultural programmes of “West Zone Cultural Centre” at football ground, Moti Daman on the eve of Liberation Day.
- 43 Nos. of farmer have been trained on organic farming.
- Training programme has been organized by National Institute of Public Co-operation and Child Development (NIPCCD) at Diu from 09/12/2013 to 13/12/2013 on “Block Level ICDS Functionaries for Quality Improvement in ICDS Programme” in which Angarwadi workers and MukhyaSevikas were sensitized on the topic.
- Training of all Head of Offices was organized from 16/12/2013 to 18/12/2013 in which “Rules for Government Purchase and e-Tendering” topic was covered.
- Census 2011 Data Dissemination workshop was held at Daman in which Heads of Office were sensitized on 2011 Census data of Daman and Diu as compared to all India.
- “Daman District Inter School Athletic Meet 2013-14” was inaugurated by Hon’ble Administrator in presence of other dignitaries on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2013. The meet was organized from 11.12.2013 to 14.12.2013 at football ground, Moti Daman in which 1,800 Nos. of Students Under 14, 17 & 19 (Boys & Girls) categories participated.

- Sports Meet at Pariyari Gram Panchayat was organized under the scheme of “PanchayatKridaKhelAbhiyan (PYKKA)” in which 180 Nos. of participants (Men & Women) of PariyariPanchayat had participated in the events like Tug of War, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Musical Chair and other community interactive games.
- “Daman Half Marathon-2013” was flagged off by Hon’ble Administrator in presence of other dignitaries on 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2013 from football ground, Moti Daman in which 1,700 Nos. of participants made it successful. Cultural Programmes were also organized by BalBhavan at different places in the route of Half Marathon i.e. at football ground, Tin Batti and Kadaiya at Daman.
- “Daman District Inter School Boxing Tournament 2013-14” was organized on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2013 in which 100 students of 8 Schools of Daman District had made the program a great success.
- “Daman District Inter School” and “U.T. level Karate Tournament-2013” were organized on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 in which 50 Nos. of Students participated.

**E. Recruitment (Appointment / Promotion) made during the month.**

- 3 Nos. of Staff Nurse were promoted to the post of Ward Sister and 1 Nos. of Staff Nurse was promoted to the post of Sister Incharge.
