

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of November 2014)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of November, 2014 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of November, 2014:

- Construction of workshop building at Govt. Polytechnic, Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 311.99 lakh.
- Construction of extension of fishing platform by providing C.C. wall with back earth filling and soling on top towards creek side at Pavti, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 168.44 lakh.
- Establishment of 66/11 KV 2 x 15 MVA S/S along with associated line at Zari, Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 70.00 lakh.
- Providing and laying of M.S. distribution pipeline for water supply connecting from Machhiwad pump house to adjoining areas at Nani Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 30.09 lakh.
- Providing, supplying and fixing 3 Nos. pre-fabricated cabins for cafeteria at tourist places in Diu at a cost of Rs. 14.00 lakh.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of November, 2014:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The

progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of November, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Agriculture**

- Sprayer Pumps has been distributed to the 16 Nos. of SC/ST/ Small & Marginalized (**SM**) farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Storage bin set has been distributed to the 120 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (**06 beneficiary**) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher, winnowing fan, submersible water pump (**04 beneficiaries**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to 16 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about 10492 students (Std. I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.
- Stipend of Rs. 1.62 lakh (Rs. 1000/ per month per trainee) has been paid to 81 numbers of trainees under TSP for 2 months training from 1/09/2014 to 31/10/2014.

➤ **Health**

Financial assistance released for a total of Rs. 65,000/- to 13 Mothers under Matru Samrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to 3771 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to 422 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 1290 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 110 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to 10,007 old age pensioners, Widows pensioners and Disabled pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of November, 2014:

➤ Sports

- “**U.T. Level Tournament**” for selection of Tennis Ball Cricket under- 19 Boys and Girls, Cricket team of under- 17 Boy and Badminton under- 17 Boys and Girls was organised at Diu from 5th to 9th November, 2014.
- Daman District **Inter School Tournament/Selection camp** of Football team of under – 19 Boys, Cricket team of under- 14 Boys, Football team of under – 14 Boys and Cricket team of under- 19 Boys was organised at Daman from 12th to 15th November, 2014.
- Cricket team of under-17 Boys, Boxing under- 14 and 17 Boys and Badminton under- 14 and 17 Boys and Girls had participated in 60th National School Games at Gwalior, Anandpur Sahib (Panjab), Ranchi & Jammu & Kashmir respectively from 12th to 15th November, 2014.
- Daman Open Cycle Race- 2014 for men and women of age group 16 years and above of age was organised on 25th November, 2014 in which 500 young youths had participated in the race.

➤ Bal Bhavan

- ‘**Bal Mela- 2014**’ was organised at Daman on 20th November, 2014. About 600 children and parents visited the various stalls of Bal Mela.
- ‘**Aranya Parv- 2014**’ was organised at Daman in collaboration with West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur. About 200 tribal artist of Western state of India has given their performance.
- Children had participated in **National Integration Camp** at National Bal Bhavan, Delhi from 12th to 22nd November, 2014.
- A cultural Programme under ‘**MAHAK- 2014**’ and ‘**RAKSHAK-2014**’ has been organised at Diu on 3rd November, 2014 and 26th November, 2014 respectively.
- ‘**Quomi Ekta Diwas**’ was observed on 23rd November, 2014. About 200 students has participated in the programme.
- Speech competition was organised on Bal Diwas, prizes were distributed to best student at Nehru Park, Diu.

➤ **ICDS**

- 14th November, 2014 is celebrated as '**Bal Diwas**'. One day seminar has been organised in various Panchayats of Daman & Diu to create awareness in the community on rights of child, healthcare, nutrition, sanitation, child labour etc.
- **Bal Swachhta Mission campaign** was organised from 14th to 19th November, 2014 during the ICDS week. Western Regional Centre team, Indore has visited Daman District from 17th to 19th November, 2014 for monitoring of Bal Swachhta Mission.

➤ **Education**

- **Teacher Training** was organised under RMSA at Daman from 4th to 8th November, 2014 for the teachers of Govt. as well as Aided schools of Daman.
- **Book Fair and Science Exhibition** has organised under RMSA on 29th November, 2014 at Diu.
- Degree College, Diu has organised **Carrier Counseling programme** for the college students on 29th November, 2014.
- Health checkup camp was organised under SSA in both districts of Daman & Diu. 105 differently-able students were examined by specialist doctors during last week of November, 2014.
- SMC camp was organised at Diu under SSA from 25th to 27th November, 2014. About 403 SMC members were trained from various zones of Diu.

➤ **Health**

- A team of Surgeon, Physician, Epidemiologist, Microbiologist has attend training programme at Pune from 10th to 12th November, 2014 for management and treatment of **EBOLA** suspected and confirmed patients.
- Paramedical Staff has been trained on **Health Information Management** for Non-Medical Personnel at Bhopal from 17th to 21st November, 2014.
- Sr. Doctors has attended training programme of **Pre Natal Diagnostic Technique (PNDT)** and **Rashtriya Bal Surksha Karyakram (RBSK)** organised by Govt. of India at Ahmadabad & Pune respectively.
- Drawing and painting competition and speech competition was organised for Std. XIII and above students for creation of awareness of HIV, AIDS during the last week of November, 2014.

- EBOLA case management and treatment training was organised at Diu on 20th November, 2014. Doctors and para medical staffs in Diu were trained on EBOLA case management and universal precautionary measures taken while dealing with EBOLA suspected/confirmed patients.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

Provided 183 grown and vaccinated poultry bird at nominal case rate of Rs. 100/- kg base to 2 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Fire**

Mock drill on fire safety has been organised at Bucharwada, Diu in which students were sensitized about fire safety.

D. Law and Order

- From 1st November, 2014 onwards Daman Traffic Police has launched a intensified traffic drive. Two wheeler riders failing to wear a helmet are issued challan.
