

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of December 2014)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of December, 2014 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of December, 2014:

- Construction of dry dock platform by providing C.C. wall with back earth filling and soling on top towards creek side at Vanakbara to Saudwadi, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 405.00 lakh.
- Construction of central store building for Electricity Department at Kachigam, Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 257.00 lakh.
- Widening of existing road into four lane road from Nagoa junction to Vanakbara, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 200.00 lakh
- Leveling by raising of existing C.C. pavement of pilani boat beaching platform and construction of Additional Ramp towards shore creek near Jalaram society at Vanakbara, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 70.00 lakh.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of December, 2014:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of December, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Agriculture**

- Sprayer Pumps has been distributed to the 21 Nos. of SC/ST/ Small & Marginalized (**SM**) farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Storage bin set has been distributed to the 98 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Pesticide has been distributed to the 99 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Bio pesticide/bio fertilizer has been distributed to the 98 Nos. of SC/ST/ SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (**27beneficiaries**) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher, winnowing fan, submersible water pump (**01beneficiary**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to 20 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

- Subsidy provided to **20 women beneficiaries** (Rs. 4.80 lakh) under the Integrated Dairy Development Project.
- Subsidy provided to 7 women beneficiaries (Rs. 7.69 lakh) under the scheme of Small Scale Dairy Unit.
- Provided 805 grown and vaccinated poultry Bird at nominal cash rate of Rs. 100/- kg base to 73 beneficiaries under Poultry Demonstration Farm Scheme.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about 14,633 students (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.
- Stipend of Rs. 81,000/- (Rs. 1000/ per month per trainee) has been paid to 81 numbers of trainees under TSP for 1 month training from 1/11/2014 to 30/11/2014.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released for a total of Rs.30,000/- to 06 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

- LIC Jeevan Kishor (one time deposit) policy of Rs. 41,800/- has been made in the name of 10 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to 7120 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to 1678 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 1944 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 255 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Rural / Urban Development**

- Pension released to 9,957 old age pensioners, Widows pensioners and Disabled pensioners under National Social Assistance Programme.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of December, 2014:

➤ **Sports**

- Daman District **Inter School Tournament 2014-15** was held at Daman from 3rd to 22nd December, 2014 at Football Ground, Daman. Various sports events like Athletic events, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Volleyball, Football were organized for the age group of 14 to 19 years (boys and girls).
- The U.T. Level selection camp for selection of player for 60th National School Games were organised in the month of December, 2014 for Kho-Kho, Volleyball and Football. All selected players had participated in 60th National School Games held in the states of Maharashtra and Goa.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- Poster Making Competition on subject “Daman Darshan”, Elocution Competition on subject “Daman Meri Nazar me” and Folk Dance Competition were organised on the occasion on Liberation Day, 2014 at Daman. About 400 students participated in these competitions.
- The 80 artist of West Zone Cultural Centre (Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Gujarat etc.) has performed various folk on 18th– 19th December, 2014 on occasion of Liberation Day.

➤ **Education**

- RMSA allocation of Rs. 3,000/- to each school has been transferred to 12 Govt. Higher Secondary School of Daman for Self Defense Training to the Girls.

- Study tour was organised under RMSA for the secondary level students of Diu district.
- SMDC member / Community Leader were trained under RMSA at Diu.
- The Hon'ble Administrator, UT of Daman & Diu has motivated all Principals, Head Masters and Teachers of Govt. Schools on 13th December, 2014 towards providing quality education.
- "GyanGaurav Award" function was organised at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium, Daman on 22nd December, 2014 in which best academic students were awarded by the Hon'ble Administrator and other dignitaries.

➤ **Health**

The world AIDS day function was organised in both districts of Daman & Diu. Students and youth were sensitized on killer disease HIV/AIDS through elocution competition, poster competition, debate competition etc.

➤ **Tourism**

The Tourism Department has organised 21 Kms half Marathon race at Daman on 14th December, 2014 for promotion of tourism. About 2000 youths had participated in the race in which Shri DevidCiptok of Nigeria, was the winner of the half Marathon.

➤ **Agriculture**

Two days training programme for farmers has been organised on "Integrated Pest Management of Mango/Chickoo Orchards". About 29 No. of farmers has attended the Training programme.

D. Recruitment (Appointment / Promotion) made during the month.

- One post of Field Surveyor have been filled up in office of City Survey Department, Daman.
- 1 post of Sanitary Inspector has been filled up by promotion and 1 post of Medical Officer has been filled up on contract basis in Directorate of Medical and Health Services.

E. Other Important Activity (in brief):

- The UT Administration has started "Jan Sunvai" in which the Development Commissioner, UT of Daman & Diu is visiting in the villages with team of Sr. Level Officers to hear the public problems /issues at the door step of villagers.

The “Jan Sunvai Programme” was organised on 28th December, 2014 at Village Bhimpore, Daman.

- The Supervisors deputed by Govt. of India has visited the Aanganwadi Centers of Daman district on 20th December, 2014.
- The Hon’ble Administrator has inaugurated 66/11 KV, 2 x 15 MVA sub-station at, Kachigam, Daman in presence of Hon’ble Member of Parliament and other dignitaries on 19th December, 2014.
- The Hon’ble Administrator has inaugurated the “SaralSeva Kendra” in presence of Hon’ble Member of Parliament and other elected public representative and officers at Dabhel Panchayat on 19th December, 2014.
- Single Window System has been inaugurated in Daman Municipal Council on 2nd December, 2014.
- The “Beti Bachao and Beti Padhao” awareness campaign were organised at various Anganwadi Centers of Daman. The women groups sensitized on the issue of declining in sex ratio and its ill impact on society.
