Under section 8 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

This is about a proposal received from the Commanding Officer, Station Land Acquisition Officer, Indian Coast Guard Air Station, Nani Damam for the acquisition of land admeasuring 65607.50 Sq. Mtrs. at Village Marwad and Kathiria, Nani Damam for Acquisition of land for extension of airfield facilities for Indian Coast Guard Air Station, Damam.

The agency M/s. SR Asia, Ghaziabad, Uttarpradesh has been appointed vide Order No. 2/COL/DMN/SIA/122/Vol.I/2021/3467 dated 27/09/2022 to conduct Social Impact Assessment study to process as per rule 7 and submit final Social Impact Assessment report with Social Impact Management Plan in Form II.

The report of the Social Impact Assessment Team is as under:

The SIA team concluded that the process of land acquisition has both positive as well as adverse impacts. But the positives impacts of this project outweigh the negative ones. Keeping the overall scenario in view, it is found that the proposed Acquisition of land for extension of airfield facilities for Indian Coast Guard Air Station, Daman would benefit the local community and society at large.

The constitution of the Independent Multi-Disciplinary expert Group under section 7(1) of the act was notified vide No.5/2/COL/LAND/RECTLARR/2017-18/2885 dated 07/09/2020 for Appraisal of Social Impact Assessment report.

The appraisal report has been submitted by the expert committee on review of the SIA and SIMP Report for Acquisition of land for extension of airfield facilities for Indian Coast Guard Air Station, Daman vide Appraisal Report dated 22.11.2022 is as under:


1. The acquisition of land and properties has been necessitated to provide more basic amenities to the local people.
2. The estimated number of families being affected is about 51 Private land parcels and 2 Govt. Land parcels.

Recommendations and Observations of the Committee are as under:

2. The M/s. SR Asia, Ghaziabad, Uttarpradesh requests the District Administration to note that all the points mentioned in (Social Impact) and (SIMP) of SIA Report, must be considered to mitigate the adverse effect on Land/Property Holders.
