

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of July 2014)**

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of July, 2014 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) New Major Works started during the month of July, 2014:**

Work order placed to Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL) for establishment of 1 x 160 MVA + 2 x 50 MVA, 220/66/11 KV S/S at Ringanwada, Daman along with associated 220 KV D/C line from 400 KV new PGCIL S/S to Ringanwada, Daman at a cost of Rs. 39.95 Crore.

**(ii) Major Works completed during the month of July, 2014:**

- Leveling of newly acquired land for extension of runway at airport, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 3.28 Crore.
- Development of ground (Swami Vivekanand Sports Complex) near Govt. College has been completed at a cost of 3.20 Crore and inaugurated by Hon'ble Administrator on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.
- Widening and Re- Carpeting of Road at Simbor- Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 49.95 lakh.
- Construction of Tourist Assistance Booth at Jampore Beach has been completed at a cost of Rs. 39.00 lakh and inaugurated by Hon'ble Administrator on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.
- Construction of RCC Cycle track at MDR from Kevdi Camping side to Nagoa Beach, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 42.00 lakh.
- Construction of Greenhouse shed in Agriculture Farm at Malala, Diu at a cost of Rs. 5.04 lakh.

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of July, 2014:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of July, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to 12 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

Subsidy provided to 5 women beneficiaries (Rs. 3.35 lakh) under the Integrated Dairy Development Project.

➤ **Education**

- Phase III Workshop on Project 'A' of Sarvottam by CII-IQ, Bangalore was organized at Daman from 30<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2014. The Hon'ble Administrator, Secretary (Edu.) and other dignitaries has inaugurated the workshop and finalized the Vision and Mission statement of Sarvottam Project. Now 60 Schools of UTs of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli are covered under this project.
- Provided nutritious food to about 8840 students (Std. I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released for a total of Rs.2.80 lakhs to 56 Mothers under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.
- LIC JeevanKishor (One time deposit) policy of Rs.41,800/- has been made in the name of 34 girl child under Dikri Development Scheme (DDS).

➤ **Agriculture**

- Fertilizer has been distributed to the 1390 Nos. of SC/ST/Small and Marginalized (SM) farmers on 50% subsidy.

- 916 Nos. of Coconut Plants has been distributed to the 229 Nos. of SC/ST/SM farmers on 100% subsidy.
- Storage bin set (199 beneficiaries) and Sprayer Pumps (19 beneficiaries) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (51 beneficiaries) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher (2 beneficiaries) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided nutritious food to 7681 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided Food grain to 1900 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided nutritious food to 2016 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided nutritious food to 309 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

➤ **Development of SC/ST/OBC**

- Cash incentive of Rs. 5.60 lakh released to parents of SC/ST boy students.
- Cash incentive of Rs. 5.29 lakh released to parent of SC/ST girl students.

➤ **Technical Education**

Stipend of Rs. 73,000/- (Rs. 1000/ per month per training) has been paid to 73 numbers of trainees under TSP for 1 month training from 1/06/2014 to 30/06/2014.

**C. Organisation of important Events during the month of July, 2014:**

- “Daman District Inter School “SubrotoMukerjee Cup”Football Tournament-2014-15” was organized from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2014 for boys of under 17 years.
- July, 2014 was celebrated as ‘Anti Dengue Month’.
- Board Meeting of the BalBhavan Board members was held on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2014 at BalBhavan Office, Daman.
- BalBhavan, Daman conducted first ever “South Gujarat Open Chess Tournament” at Daman in which 147 enthusiasts from 24 Schools of Daman, Vapi, Valsad, Navsari, Surat, Udwarda and other nearby places were participated in the event. 12 Gold medals awarded to the winners.
