

U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU
ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR
DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of April 2014)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of April, 2014 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) New Major Works started during the month of April 2014:

- Scheme for providing improved metering system, communication, MRT facilities & special tools and plant/workshop in Daman & Diu at Rs.2.5 Crore is under process for financial sanction.

(ii) Major Works completed during the month of April 2014:

- Replacement and improvement of existing water supply pipeline from Magarwada Bhim Talav, Char Rasta to Excise Check Post Zari via Thana Pardi at Moti Daman.
- Renovation of the Agriculture office at Moti Daman.
- Improvement and Widening of road starting from Police Chowky to Magarwada Talav via Bharwad Falia at Moti Daman.
- Providing underground cable power distribution system in city, rural and industrial area at Rs.8.5 Crore has been completed.

B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of April 2014:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of April, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

- Supply of Paddy, Pulses, tools/Implements, Sprayer Pumps, Storage bin set and Agriculture machinery (50 % Subsidy) to 4 farmers.
- Tractors facility has been provided to 2 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Education**

- Provided nutritious food to about 14433 students (Std. I to VIII) under Mid Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Health**

- Financial assistance released of total Rs.55,000/- to 11 Mothers under Matru Samrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiaries.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided nutritious food to 7662 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided Food grain to 1870 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided nutritious food to 1905 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided nutritious food to 405 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

C. Organisation of important Events during the month of April 2014:

- Fire Safety Week was observed from 14th April, 2014 to 20th April, 2014. Activities relating to awareness i.e. training, lectures and demonstrations on basic fire prevention and fire protection was provided for Industrial Employees, Hotel Management Staffs and ITI students. Fire Safety booklets were also distributed. “Fire Service Commemoration Day Parade” was observed on 14th April, 2014 to pay homage to those brave fire personnel who lost their lives in performance of their duties.
- Summer Coaching Camp has been organized by Sports Department from 18th April, 2014 to 9th May, 2014 for Cricket, Swimming, Athletic, Volleyball, Football, Badminton and Lawn Tennis in which total 450 students participated.
- Special Coaching Camp for Archery by trained and qualified coach from Delhi was organized from 18th April, 2014 to 27th April, 2014 in which 42 students participated.
- Friendly football match of U-19 players V/s Rest of Daman Senior players was organized.
- Selection of UT Level U-19 (Boys) team and U-17 (Girls) team was done for participating in 59th SGFI Boys and Girls Football Tournament respectively which is to be held at Pune and Selection of UT Level U-14, 17 & 19 (Boys) team was done for participating in 59th SGFI Boys Badminton Tournament at Agra.
- Coaching Camp has been organized for U-19 (Boys) Football Team, U-17 (Girls) Football Team and U-14, 17 and 19 (Boys) Badminton Team.
- Board Meeting of the Bal Bhavan Board members was held on 12th April, 2014 which was attended by Hon’ble Chairperson and Vice Chairman along with all the board members.

- A Creativity Workshop was organized from 15th April, 2014 to 17th April, 2014 for the children of Bal Bhavan as well as different schools. This workshop constituted of two creativities namely “Creative Science” and “Creative Writing”. Around 70 children participated with full zest in the workshop.
- Voter Awareness Campaign was conducted by Daman Municipal Council at Moti Daman and Nani Daman area in the month of April, 2014.
- General Election to the 16th Lok Sabha was conducted in free, fair and peaceful manner in the UT on 30th April, 2014.

D. Important activity (in brief).

- Training and guidance workshop was organized for the farmers in which training and guidance was given on preparation of plots for paddy sowing, preparing the beds, certified seeds, use of fertilizers, seed sowing, etc. Vegetable demonstration was also shown to the farmers in the Government Seed Multiplication Farm, Kachigam.
